**CHRIS DUDLEY AND JOHN KITZHABER IN DEAD HEAT, 41% TO 40%  
CONGRESSIONAL GENERIC BALLOT TEST: 37% DEMOCRAT, 35% REPUBLICAN  
OBAMA JOB APPROVAL: 47% APPROVE, 44% DISAPPROVE  
OBAMA ADMINISTRATION HANDLING OF OIL SPILL: 40% APPROVE, 47%  
DISAPPROVE**

**Louisville, CO** – The election for Oregon Governor is currently a statistical dead heat with 41% of likely voters supporting businessman Chris Dudley, 40% supporting former Governor John Kitzhaber, 10% support another candidate, and 9% are undecided. The ballot test numbers are based on a Magellan Strategies survey of 963 likely Oregon voters fielded Monday, June 28<sup>th</sup>. Looking at ballot test results by voter subgroup, we find Republican Chris Dudley doing well among independent voters with 41% support compared to 27% for John Kitzhaber. While appealing to independent voters is a likely priority for both campaigns, it is a higher priority for the Dudley Campaign. We say this because of past statewide voting party demographics.

In the 2006 and 2008 election cycles, Democrats averaged 45% of the total vote, followed by Republicans with 35%, and independents with 20%. For Chris Dudley to be in a position to win, he needs to appeal to a significant majority of independents. Any Democrat support for Chris Dudley, currently at 15%, will “relieve” the pressure to pick up independent voters. John Kitzhaber obviously does not need as many independent votes to get to 50%, but the larger the percentage of Democrat voters supporting Chris Dudley puts more pressure on the Kitzhaber Campaign to attract independent support. The table below shows the Governor ballot test by voter subgroup. A map of Oregon’s Congressional Districts is included in this document.

**Candidate Image Ratings**

Both candidates are well known among all voters. Former Governor John Kitzhaber has name recognition of 96%, while businessman Chris Dudley has name recognition of 93%. John Kitzhaber has an image ratio of 1 to 1, with 43% of voters having a favorable opinion of him and 40% having an unfavorable opinion. Chris Dudley has an image ratio of 2 to 1, with 42% of voters having a favorable opinion of him and 21% having an unfavorable opinion. John Kitzhaber’s image rating is slightly “upside down” among men, 43% favorable/48% unfavorable. Women have a more positive opinion of John Kitzhaber, with 43% favorable and 34% unfavorable. Chris Dudley has a stronger image among men than women, with 47% having a favorable opinion of him compared to 38% of women.

**Oregon Congressional Generic Ballot Test**

*“If the election for Congress was being held today, and all you know about the two candidates was that one was a Democrat, and the other was a Republican, for whom would you vote?”*

Among all voters, 37% of respondents would vote for the Democrat candidate and 35% for the Republican candidate, a two point margin. Looking at responses by Congressional District, we find potentially competitive environments in the 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> districts. The 4<sup>th</sup> district is represented by longtime Democrat incumbent Peter DeFazio and the 5<sup>th</sup> is represented by freshman Kurt Schrader. Peter DeFazio is being challenged by college professor Art Robinson and Kurt Schrader is facing State Representative Scott Bruun.

### **Barack Obama Job Approval**

Among all voters, 47% approve and 44% disapprove of the job Barack Obama is doing as President. Looking at responses by gender, women approve of the job Barack Obama is doing more than men, 48% to 46% respectively. The President's approval ratings by party are Republican: 14% approve, 80% disapprove, Democrat: 78% approve 13% disapprove, and among independent voters, 36% approve, 50% disapprove.

### **Obama Administration's Handling of Oil Spill**

*"Do you approve or disapprove of the Obama Administration's handling of the oil spill in the Gulf of Mexico?"*

Among all voters, 40% approve of the Obama Administration's handling of the oil spill and 47% disapprove. Among men, 51% disapprove and 40% approve, and among women, 40% approve and 43% disapprove.

### **Survey Methodology**

This survey was conducted using automated telephone touch tone technology. The sample for this survey was randomly drawn from an Oregon voter file. The response data was weighted to reflect past general election voting demographics from the 2008 and 2006 election cycles. The 963 interviews were conducted on Monday night, June 28th from 5:30 to 8 pm. This survey has a margin of error of 3.16% at the 95 percent confidence interval.

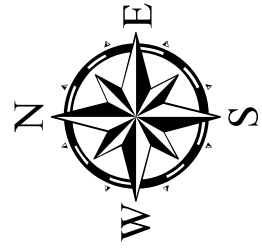

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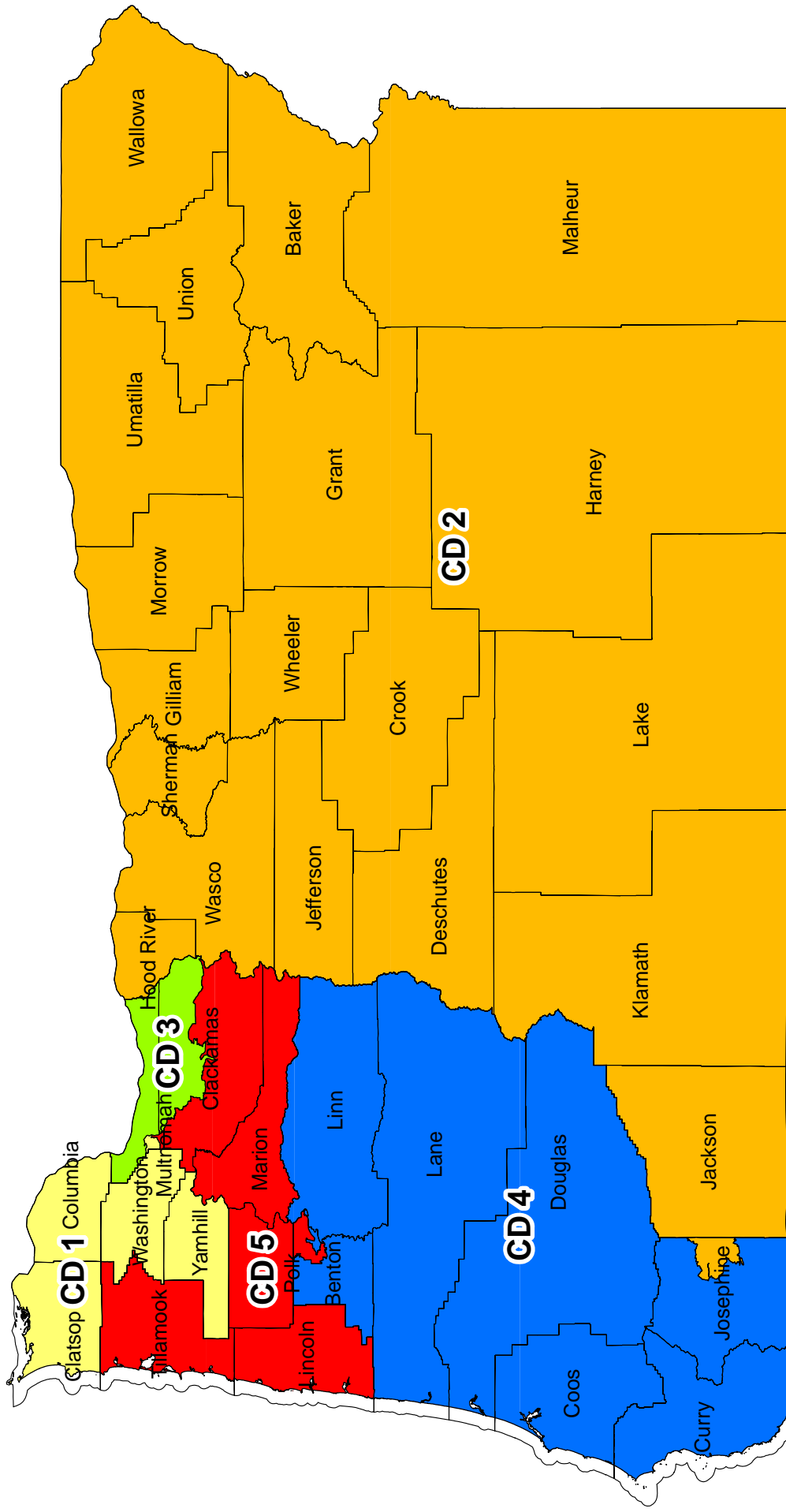

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Magellan Data and Mapping Strategies are pleased to present the topline results of a 963N autodial survey of likely general election voters in the state of Oregon. The interviews were conducted June 28<sup>th</sup>, 2010. This survey has a margin of error of +/- 3.16% at the 95 percent confidence interval. This survey was weighted based upon voter turnout demographics from the 2008 and 2006 election cycles.
