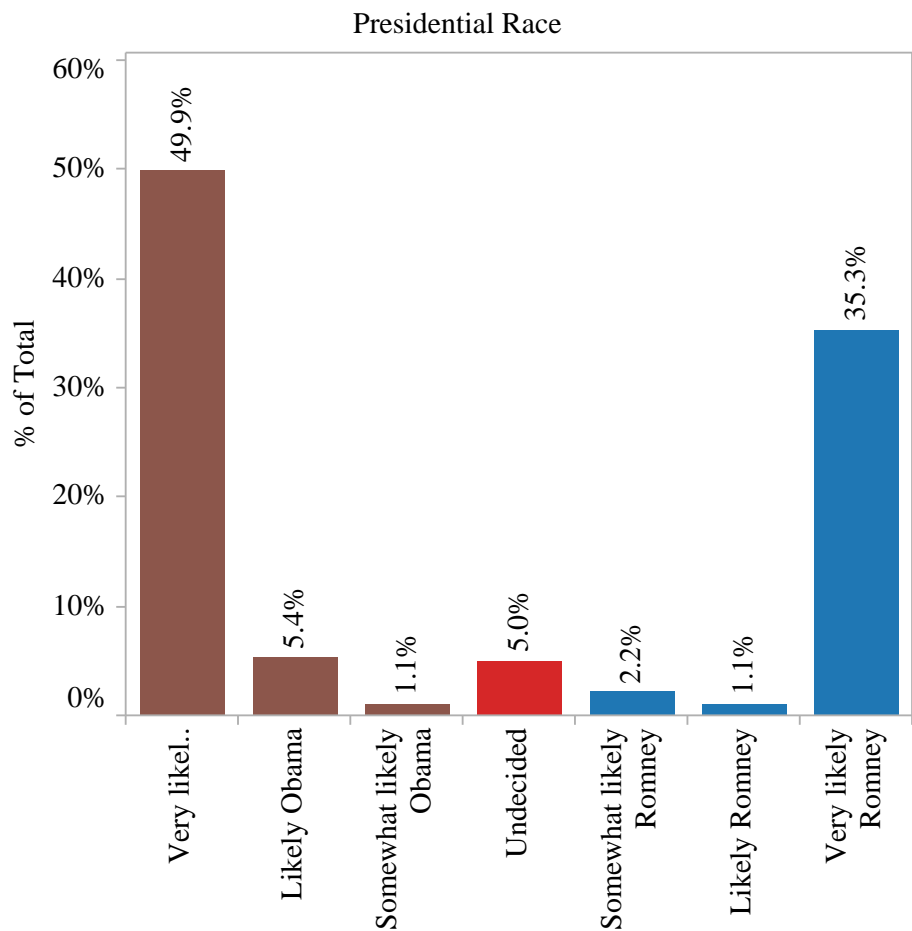

Executive Summary

On the afternoon and evenings of September 21 – 22, 2012, Gravis Marketing, a non-partisan research firm, and Capitol Correspondent conducted a survey of 625 potential voters in Washington regarding their likely vote for a given presidential candidate. The poll carries a margin of error of 4.6%.

Overall, among likely voters, Obama holds a 17.8% lead at 56.4% compared to Romney’s 38.6%, with 5.0% of likely voters still undecided.

A summary of the results is presented in the following pages.



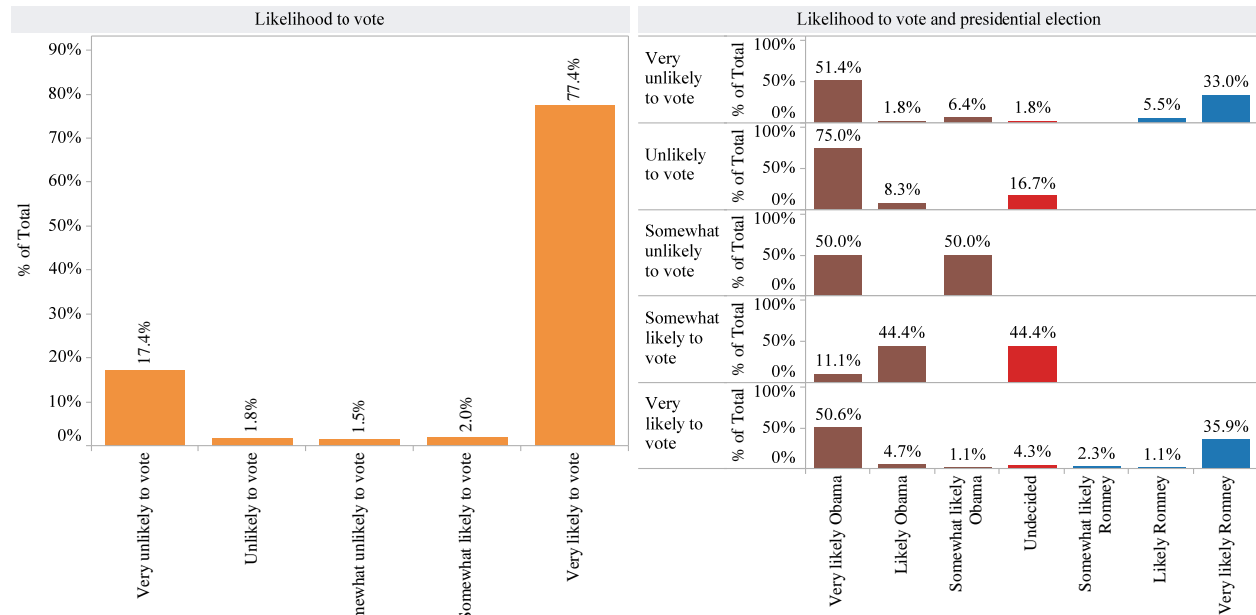
Survey Questions

1. Are you registered to vote? (Yes, No)

No crosstabs available for this question because if an individual answered no, the questionnaire stopped.

2. How likely are you to vote in this year's presidential elections? (Very unlikely, Unlikely, Somewhat unlikely, Somewhat likely, Likely, Very likely)

When looking at just the "very likely" category, Obama's lead declines to +17.1%, with 4.3% of likely voters still undecided.

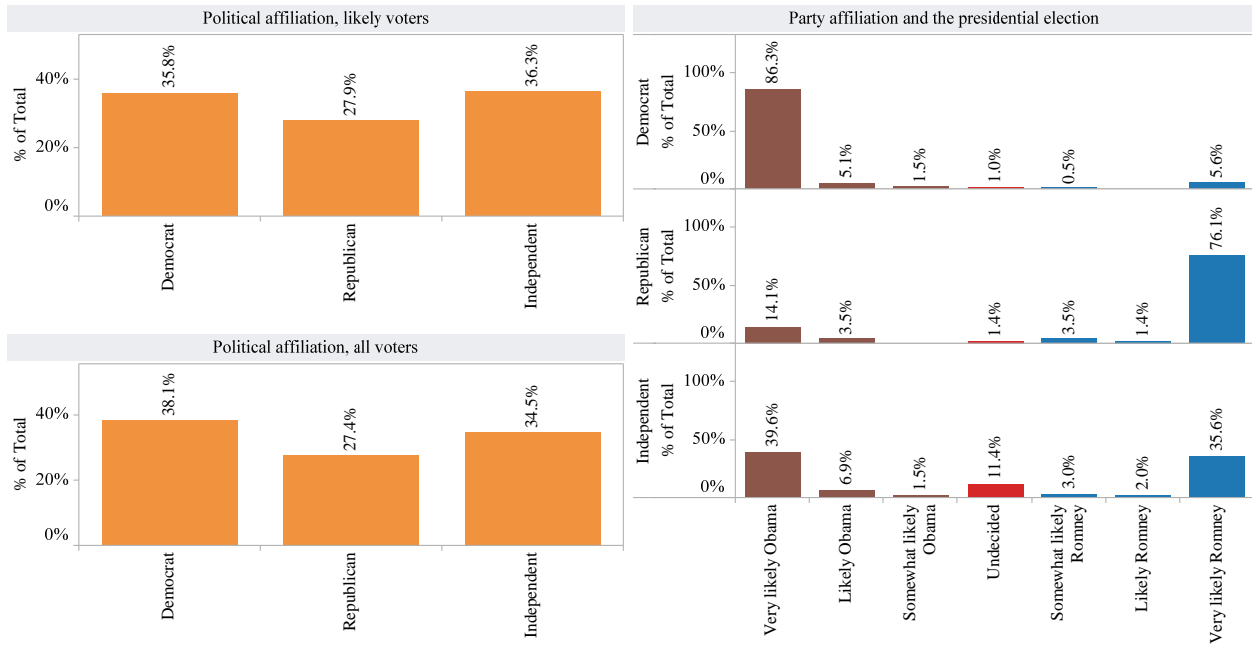

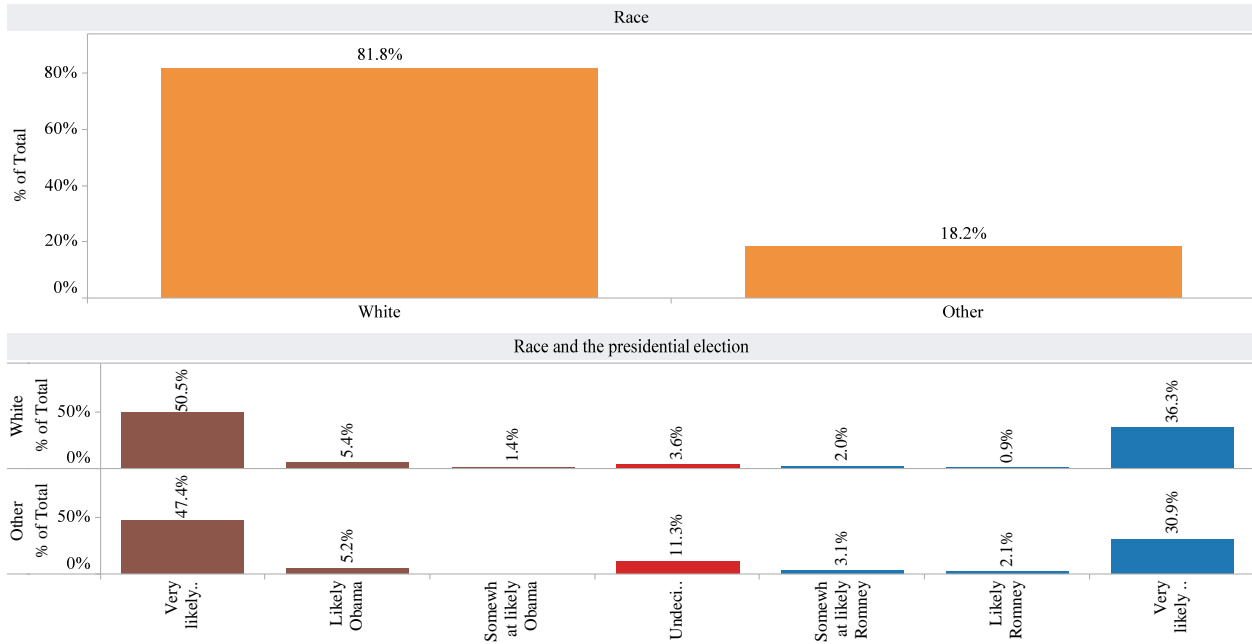
3. In which party are you either registered to vote or do you consider yourself a member of? (Democrat, Republican, independent or minority party)

Obama holds an 86.3% to 5.6% advantage among “very likely” voting Democrats, whereas Romney holds a 76.1% to 14.1% advantage among “very likely” Republicans. Obama also holds a 39.6% to 35.6% edge among “very likely” Independent voters.



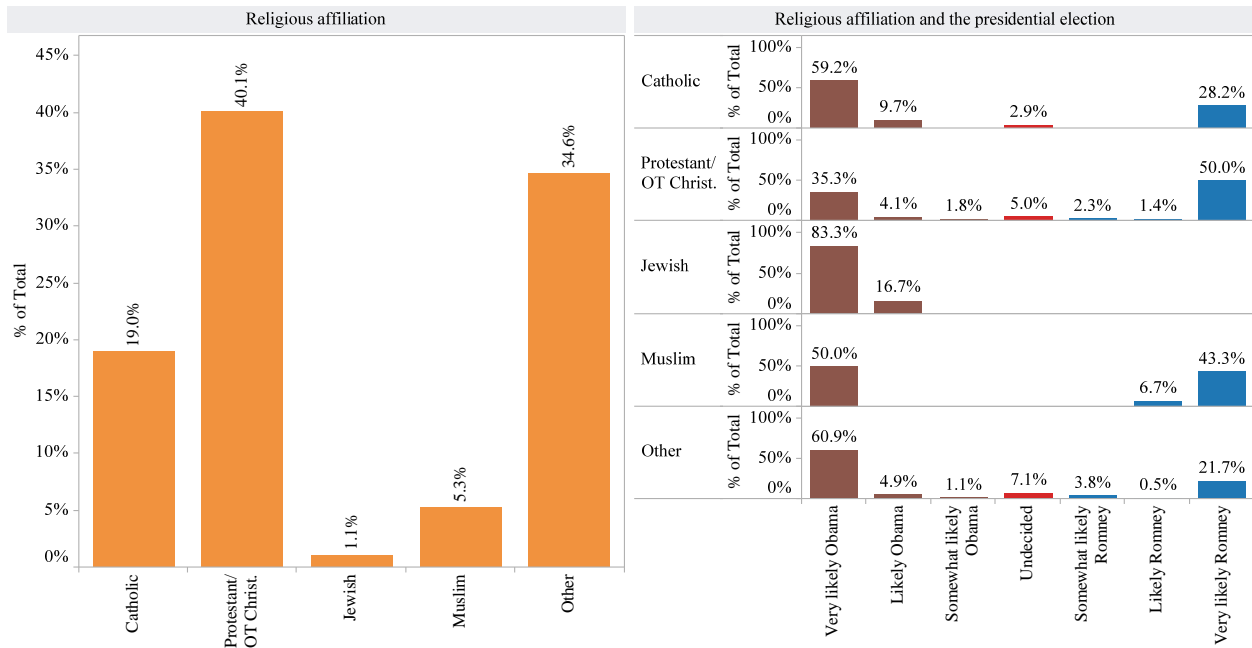
4. What race do you identify yourself as? (White/Caucasian, African-American, Hispanic, Asian, Other)

The poll of likely voters comprised a makeup of 81.8% White and 18.2% from all other races. On the whole, Obama holds a 50.3% to 36.3% lead among very likely White voters, and Obama holds a 47.4% to 30.9% lead among very likely Other race voters.



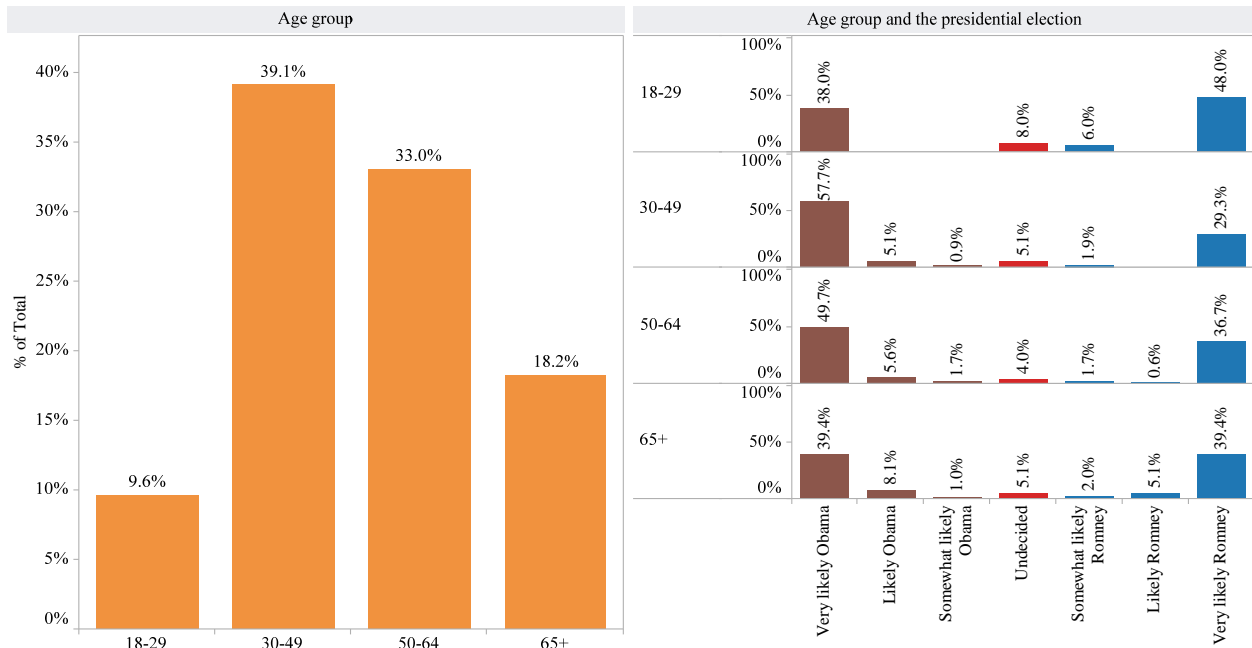
5. Which of the following best represents your religious affiliation? (Roman Catholic, Protestant/other non-denominational Christian, Jewish, Muslim, Other/no affiliation)

The largest voting groups by religious affiliation are Protestant/Other Christian, Not affiliated or Other, and Catholic. Obama holds a lead among four of the five categories, with his lead largest among Jewish and Not affiliated likely voters. On the other end, Romney holds a 50.0% to 35.3% lead among very likely Protestant/Other Christian voters.



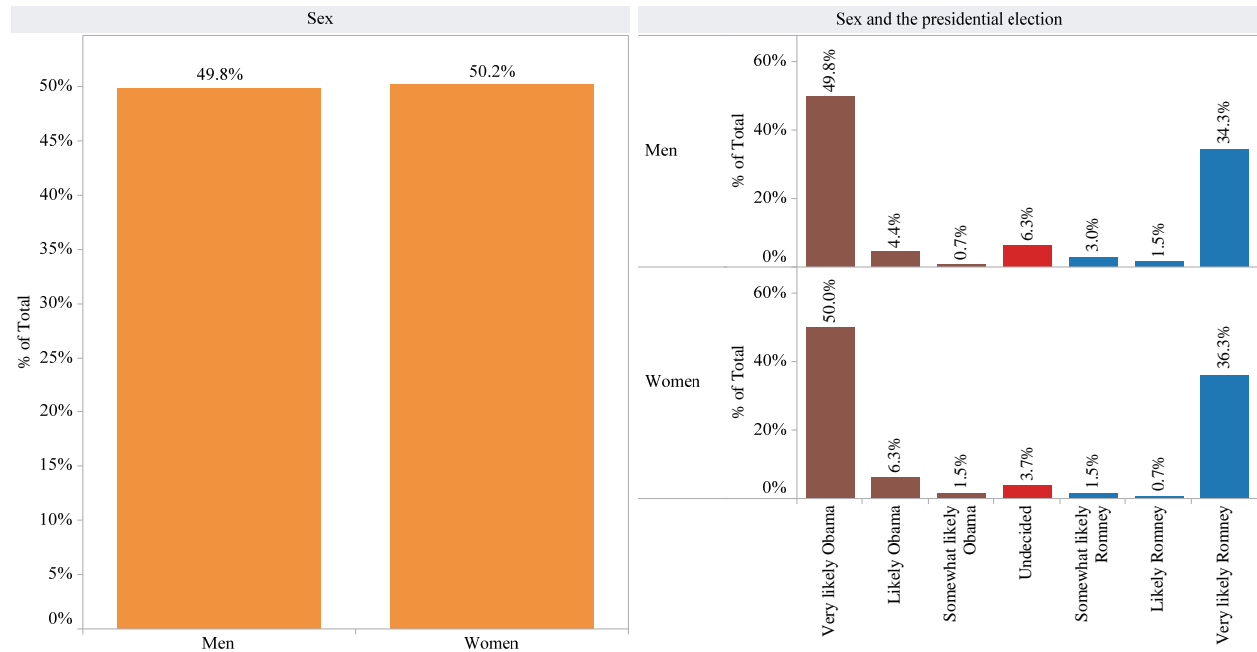
6. How old are you? (18-29, 30-49, 50-64, Over 65)

Overall, Obama has a lead among the 30-64 age groups, by a 20 to 30 point margin depending upon the age group. Interestingly, Romney holds an advantage among younger voters, with 48% indicating a very likely Romney vote in comparison to 38% for very likely Obama. The older age group (65+) is tied among the very likely voters, with Obama up by 2% among likely and somewhat likely leaning voters.



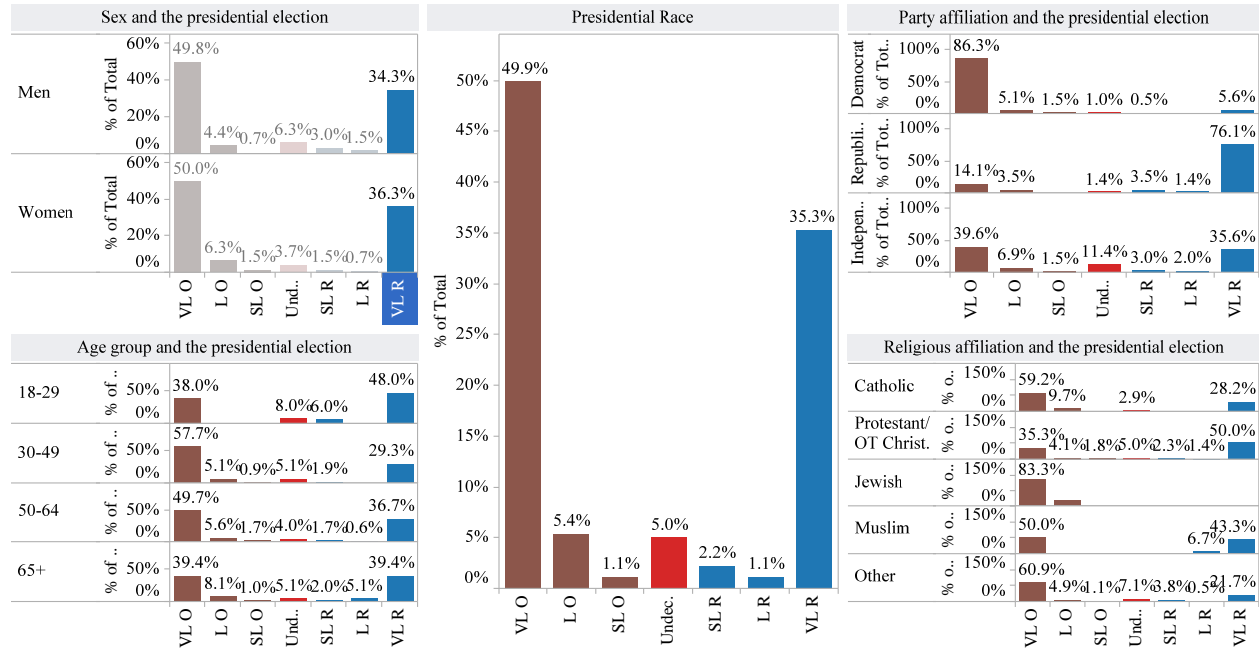
7. What is your Gender? (Male, Female)

The distinction between men and women is weak in Washington, with a 54.9% to 35.8% lead among men and a 57.8% to 38.5% lead among women.



8. If the presidential election were held today, whom would you vote for? (Very likely Obama, Likely Obama, Somewhat likely Obama, Undecided, Somewhat likely Romney, Likely Romney, Very likely Romney)
