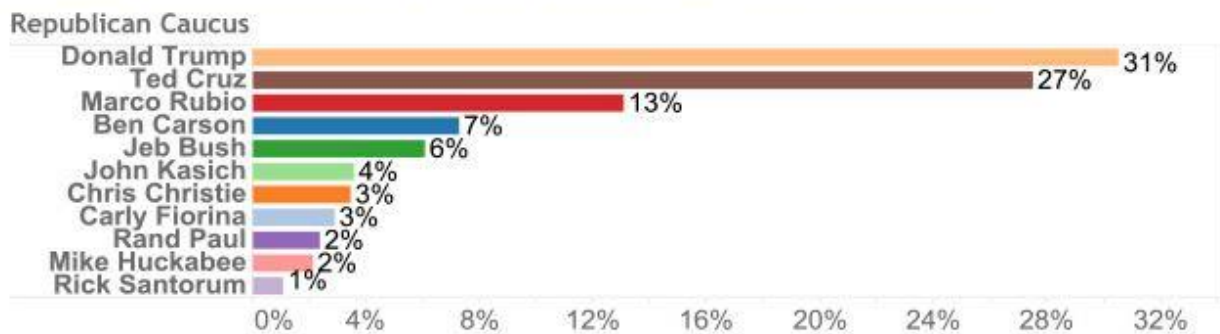


Iowa Polling Results

Gravis Marketing, a nonpartisan research firm, conducted a random survey of 1,827 registered, likely primary voters in Iowa. The poll was conducted on January 26th and 27th and includes 724 Republicans, 810 Democrats, and the remainder as independents or another party. The poll has a margin of error of $\pm 2\%$ [4% for Republicans and 3% Democrats] at the 95% confidence level. The total may not round to 100% because of rounding. The polls were conducted using automated telephone calls (IVR technology). The results are weighted by voting demographics. The poll was conducted for One America News.
