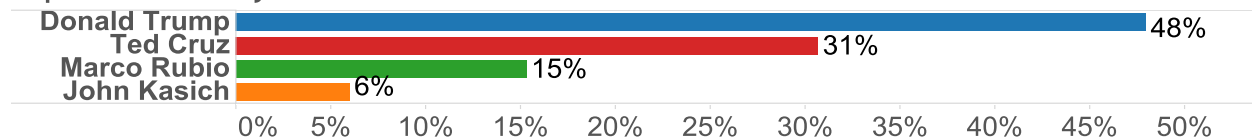

Executive Summary

Gravis Marketing, a nonpartisan research firm, conducted a random survey of 1,356 likely Republican voters in the Louisiana Republican primary. The poll was conducted March 3rd. The poll has a margin of error of $\pm 3\%$. The total may not round to 100% because of rounding. The polls were conducted using automated telephone calls (IVR technology) and online responses. The results are weighted by voting demographics.

Assuming you had to vote today, which 2016 GOP Candidate would you vote for?

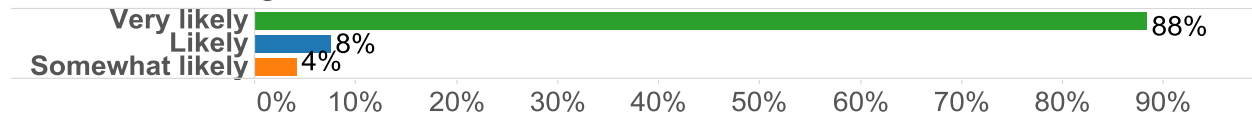

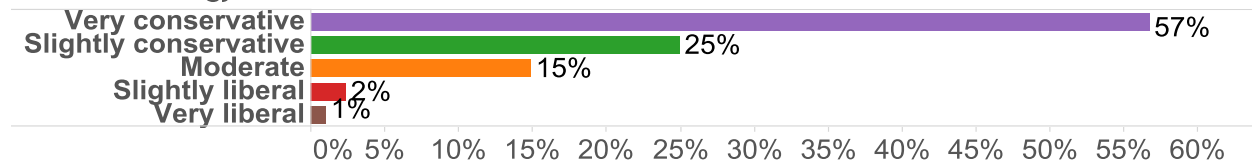
How likely are you to vote in the Louisiana Presidential Primaries?

Likelihood of Voting



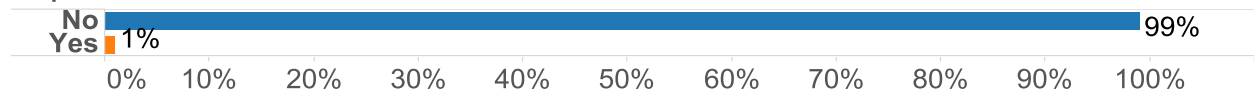
What is your political ideology?

Political Ideology



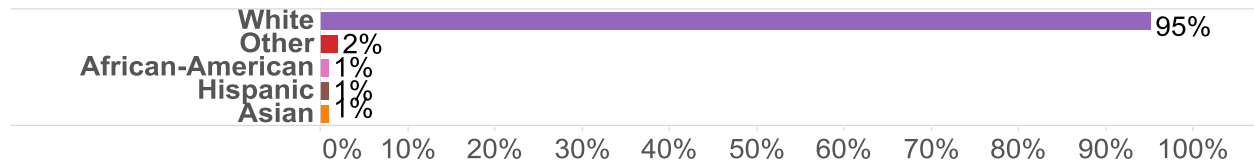
Are you or is a member of your immediate family from a Latino, Hispanic or Spanish speaking background?

Hispanic



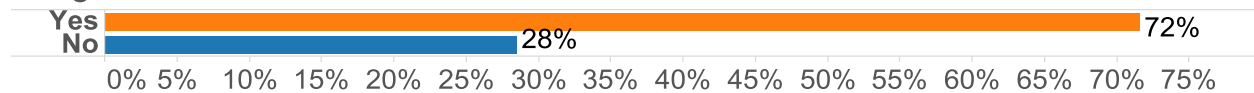
What race do you identify yourself as?

Race



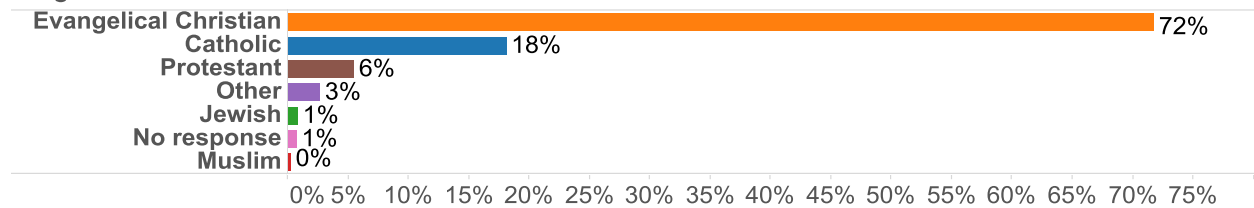
Do you identify yourself as an Evangelical Christian or another religion?

Evangelical Christian



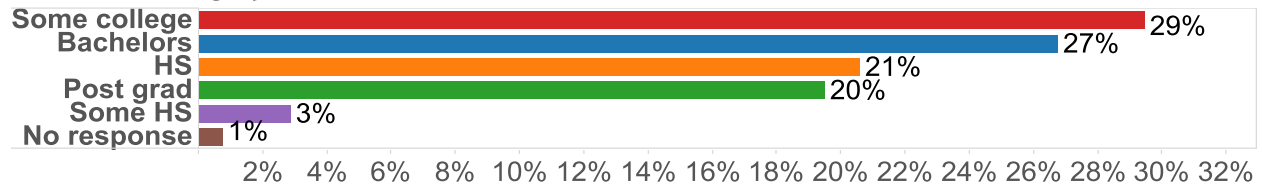
Which of the following best represents your religious affiliation?

Religious affiliation



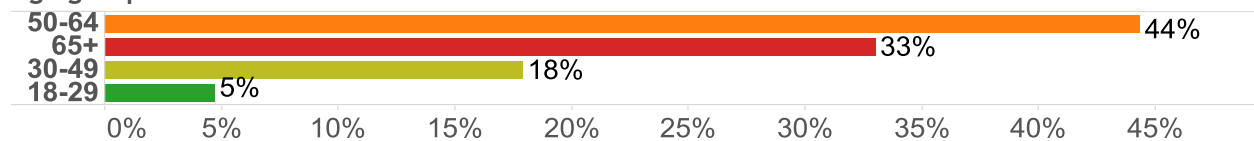
What is the highest level of education have you completed?
