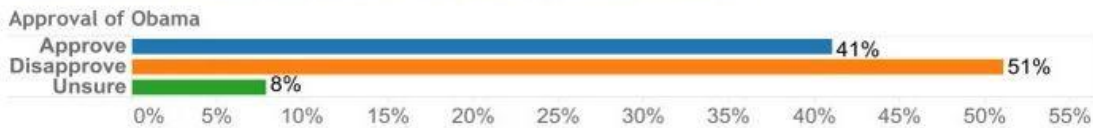


# Iowa Polling Results

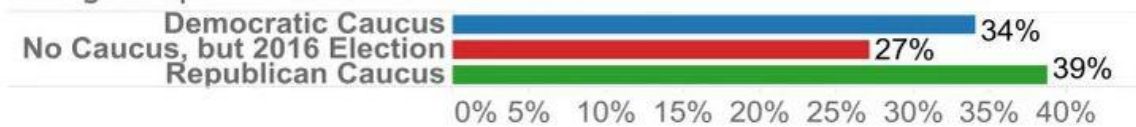
Gravis Marketing, a nonpartisan research firm, conducted a random survey of 670 registered voters in Iowa regarding the presidential election. The sample includes 227 Republican Caucus participants, 236 Democratic Caucus participants, and 207 planning to vote in 2016, but will not participate in the primary elections. The poll has a margin of error of  $\pm 3.8\%$  [6.5% for Republican Caucus/6.4% for Democratic Caucus]. The total may not round to 100% because of rounding. The polls were conducted using IVR technology and weighted separately for each population in the question presented. The poll was conducted for One American News Network.

## Do you approve or disapprove of President Obama's Job Performance?



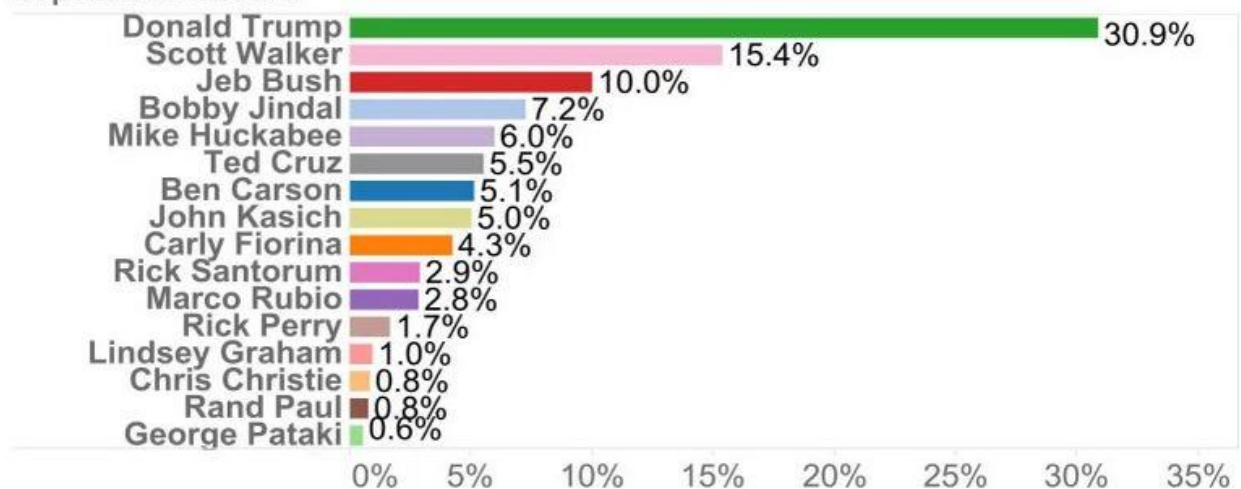
## Do you plan on voting in the Republican or Democratic Caucuses for the 2016 Presidential Election?

### Voting in Republican or Democratic Caucus?



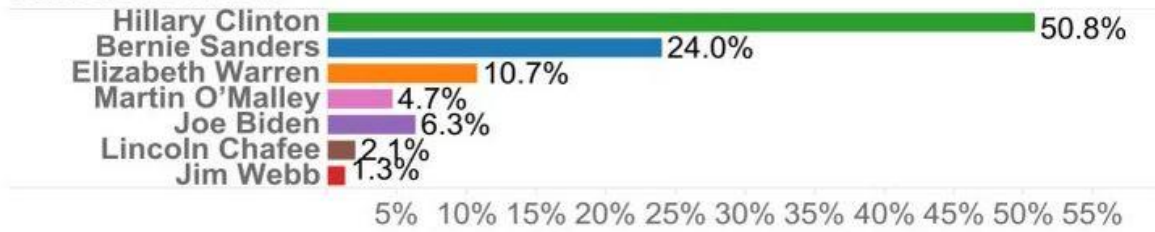
## Assuming you had to vote today, which 2016 GOP Candidate would you vote for?

Assuming you had to vote today, which 2016 Democrat Candidate would you vote for?

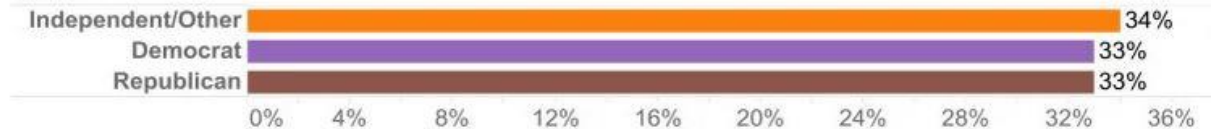

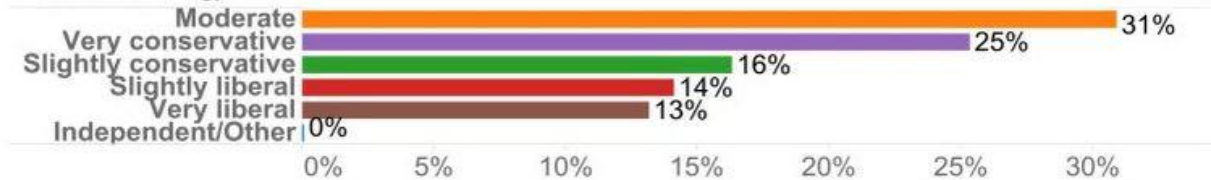

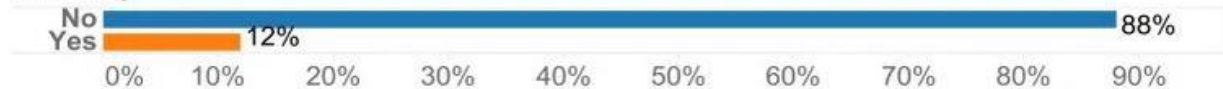
What is your political ideology?

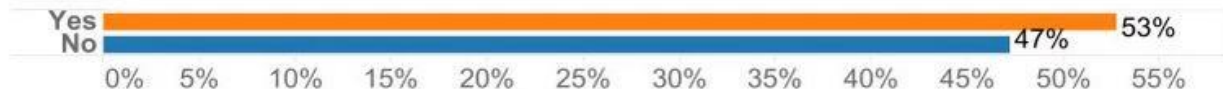
Do you consider yourself a member of the Tea Party?

Tea Party



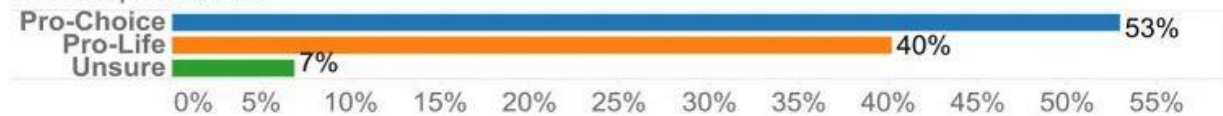
Do you or anyone in your family own a gun or firearm?

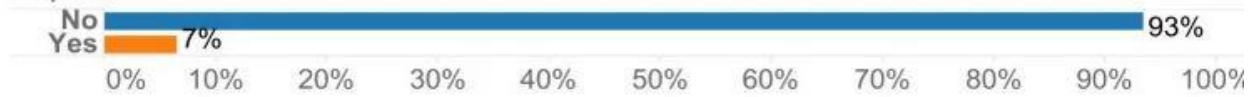
Do you consider yourself to be Pro-Life or Pro-Choice when it comes to the question of whether or not abortion should be legal?

Pro-Life | Pro-Choice



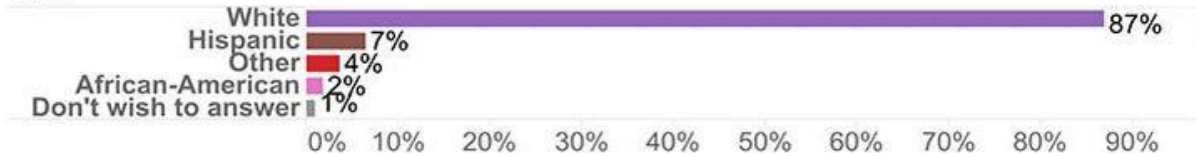
Are you or is a member of your immediate family from a Latino, Hispanic or Spanish speaking background?

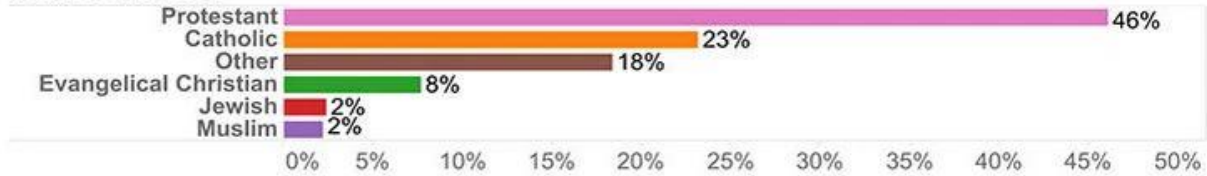
What race do you identify yourself as?

Race



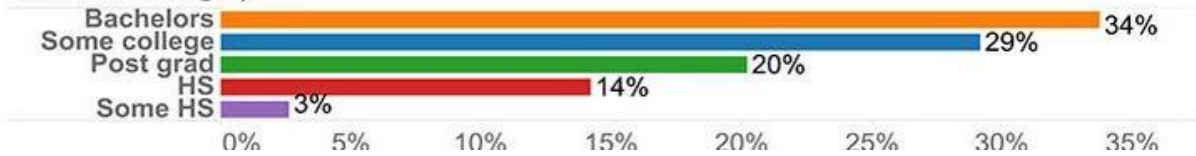
Which of the following best represents your religious affiliation?

Religious affiliation



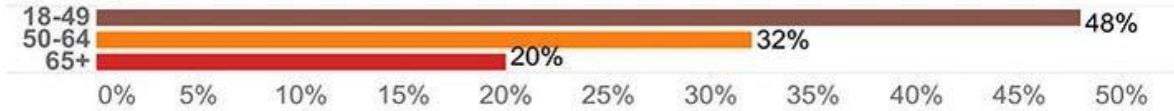
What is the highest level of education have you completed?

Education Category



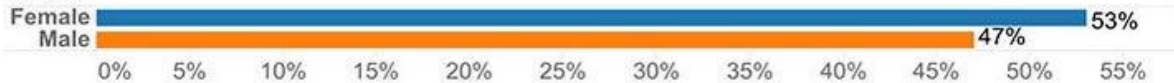
How old are you?
