### Executive Summary

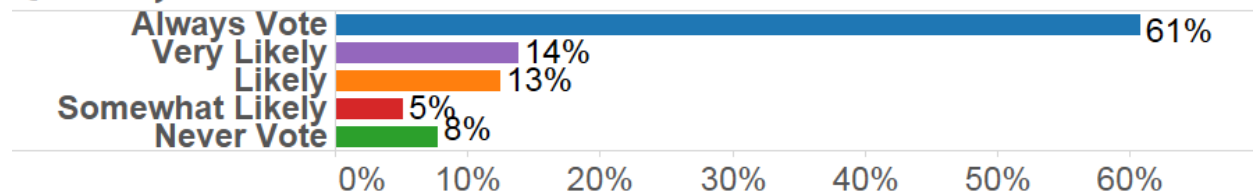
Gravis Marketing, a nonpartisan research firm, in conjunction with Breitbart News Network, conducted a random survey of 1,690 registered voters across the United States on October 3<sup>rd</sup>. The poll has a margin of error of  $\pm 2.4\%$  at the 95% confidence level. The total may not round to 100% because of rounding. The poll was conducted using automated telephone calls and online responses, with the results weighted by voting patterns.

Founded in 2005 by conservative icon Andrew Breitbart, Breitbart News Network is the biggest source of breaking news and analysis, thought-leading commentary, and original reporting curated and written specifically for the new generation of independent and conservative thinkers.

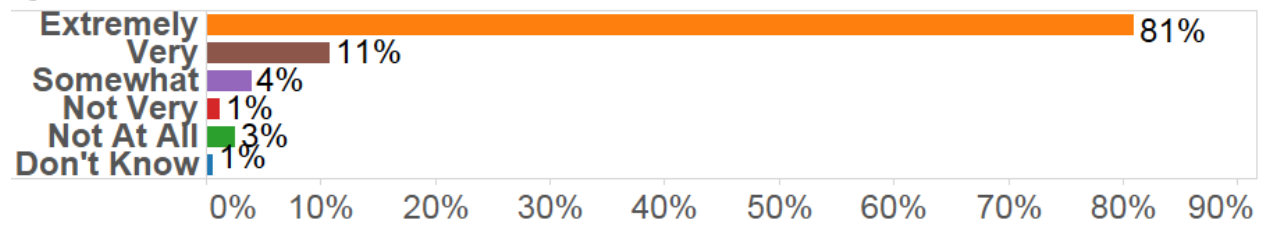
### Q2: How likely are you to vote in November?

#### Q2: Likely to Vote



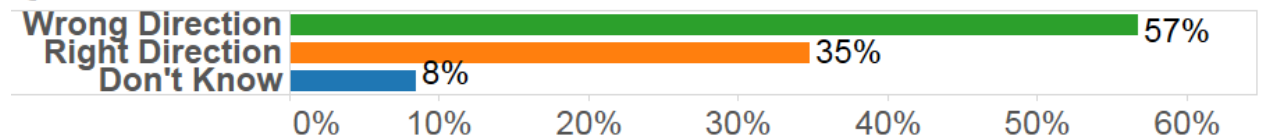
Q3: How interested are you in the 2016 Presidential election?

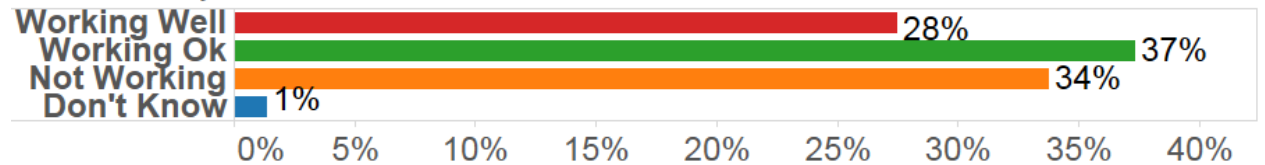
Q4: How would you describe the country's direction today?

Q4: Direction



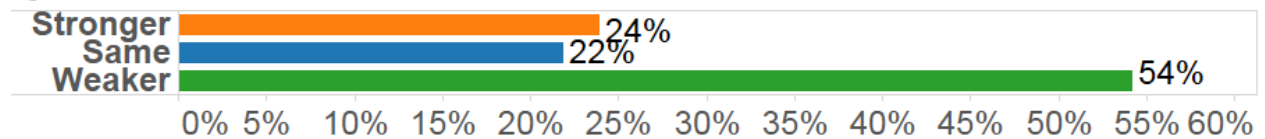
Q5: How would you describe how the American economy is working for you and your family?

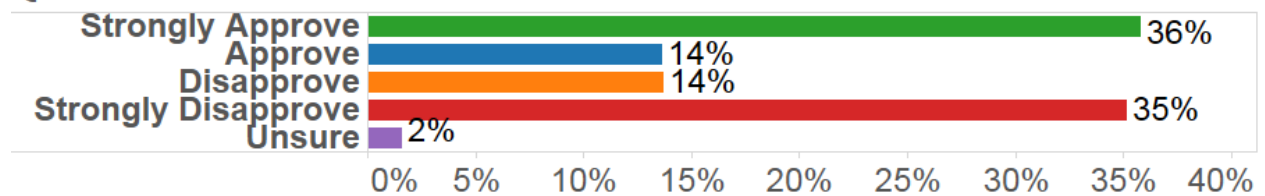
Q6: How would you describe America's position in the world today compared with America's position 10 years ago?

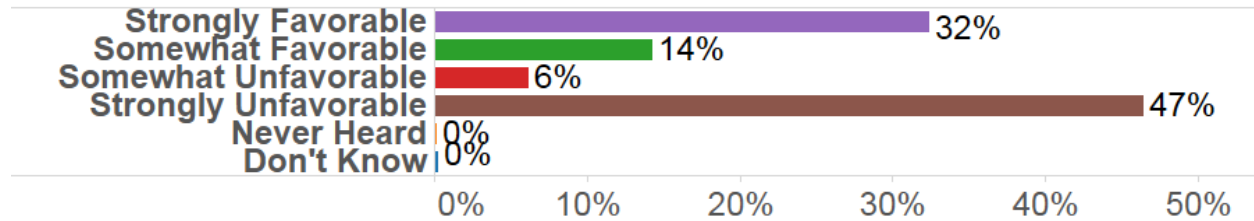

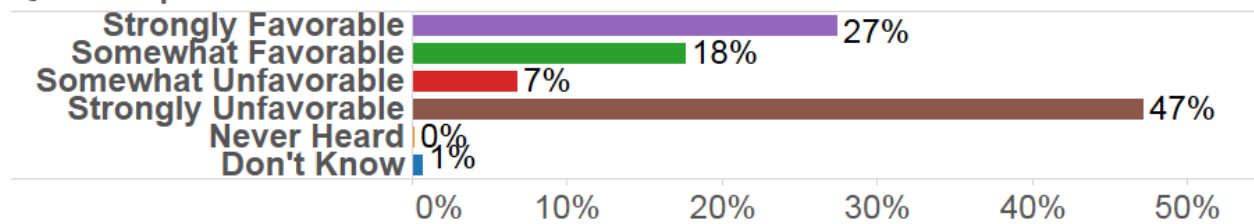

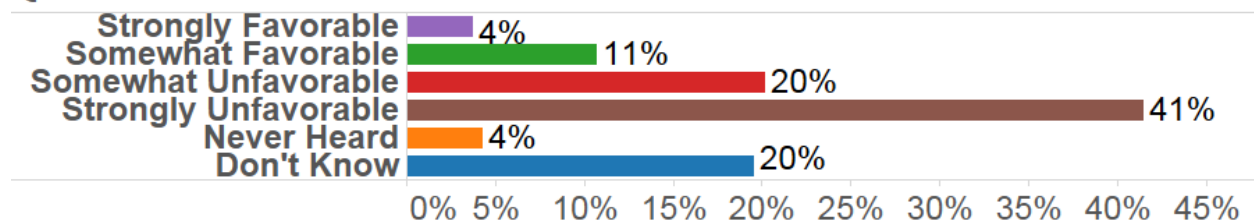

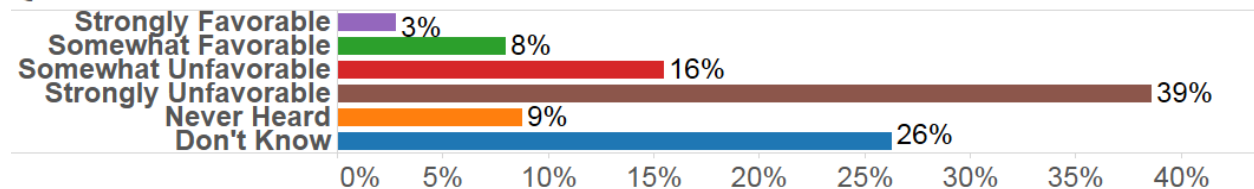

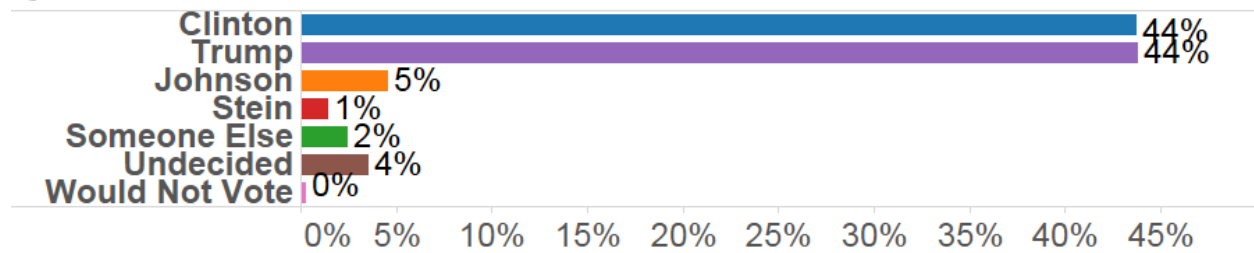

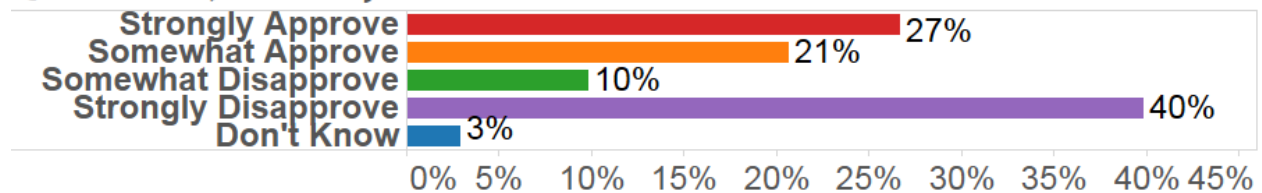

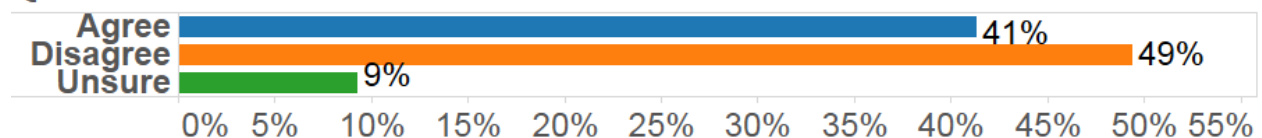

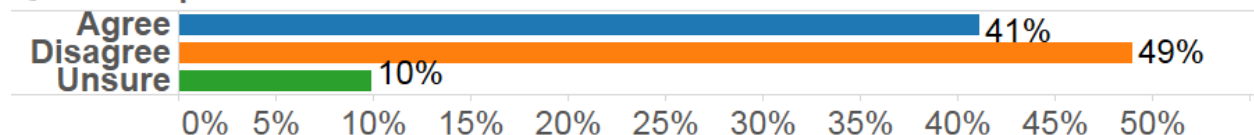

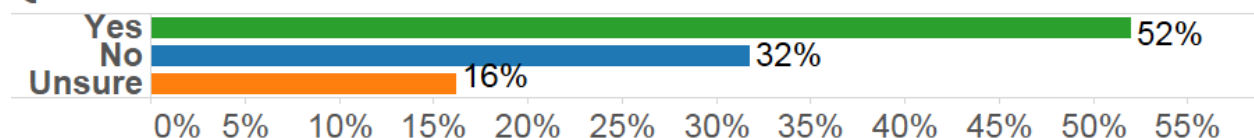

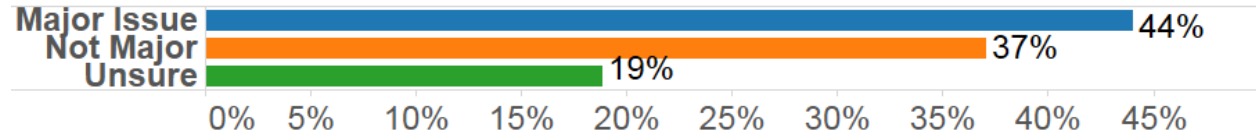

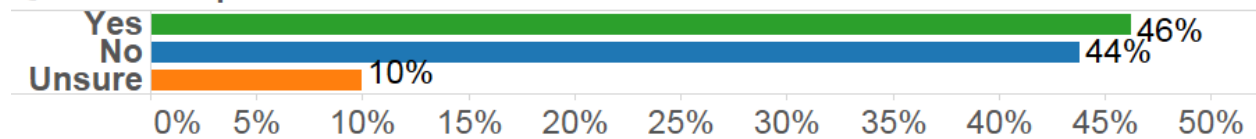

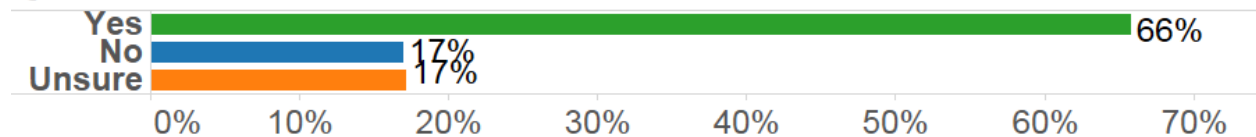

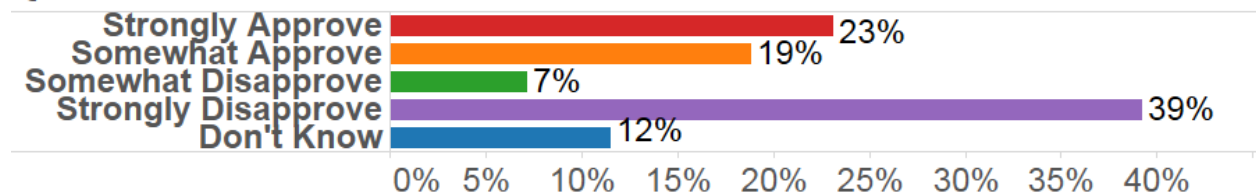

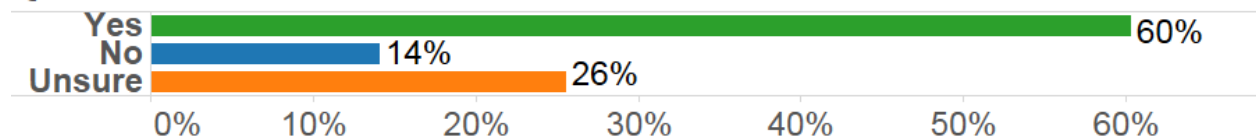

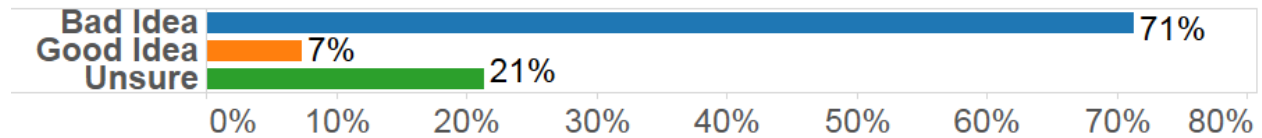

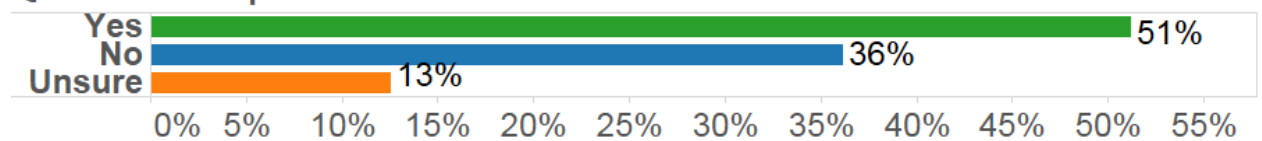

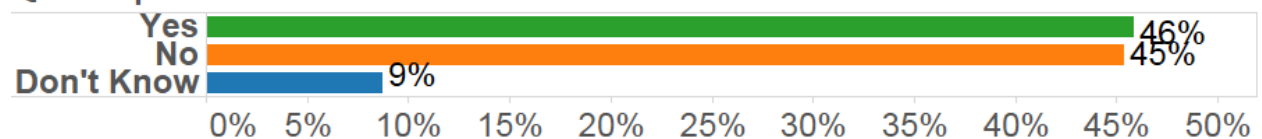

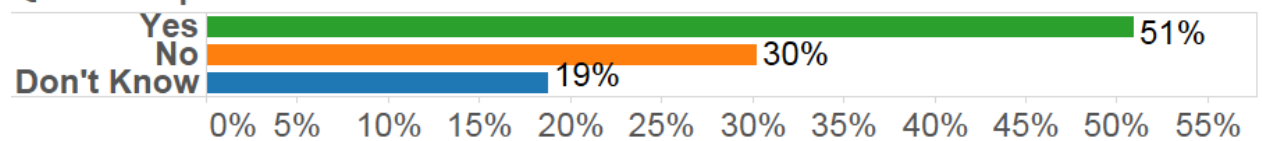

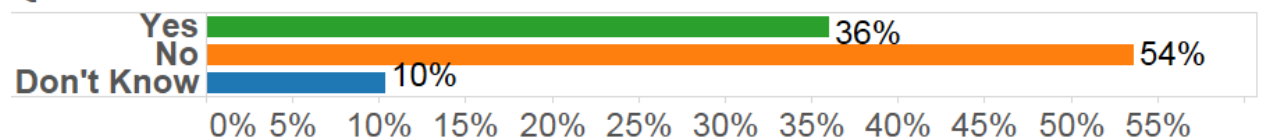

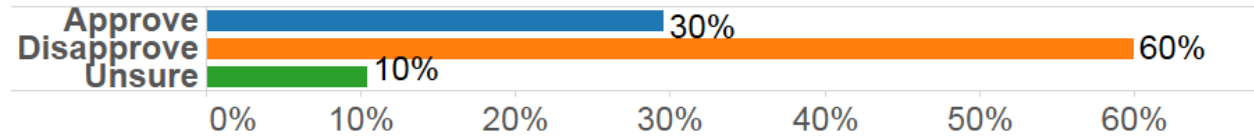

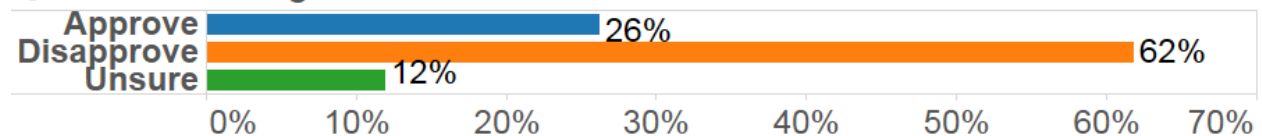

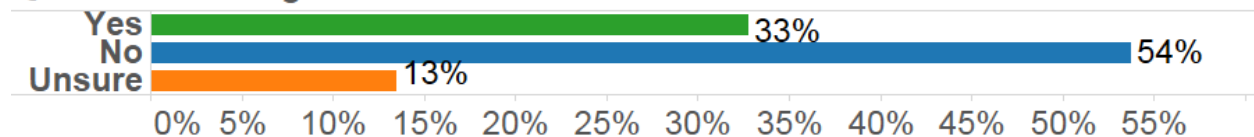

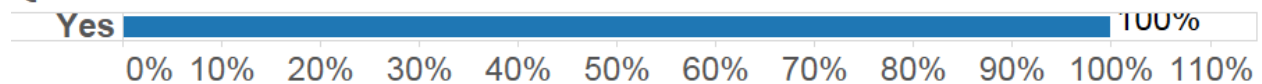

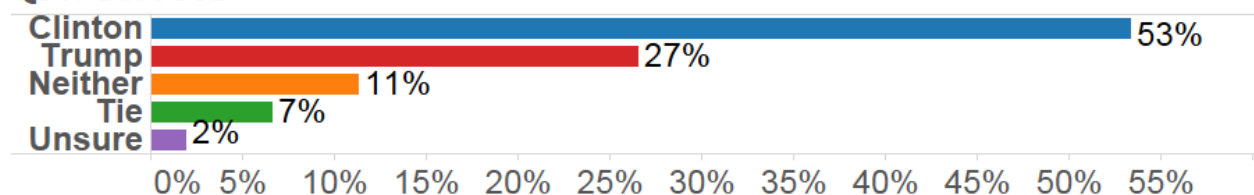

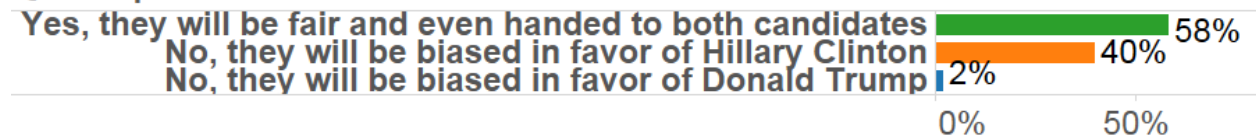

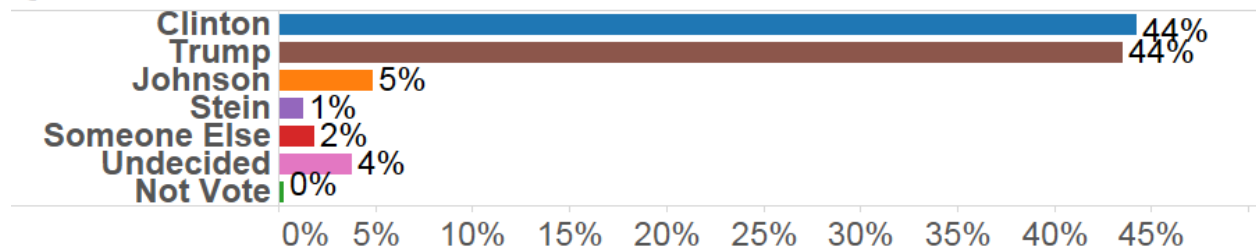

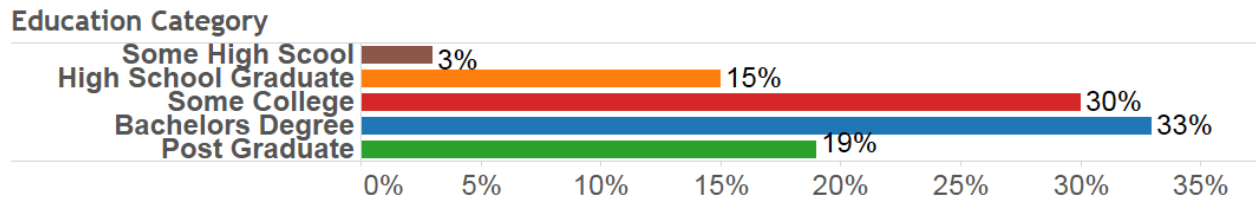

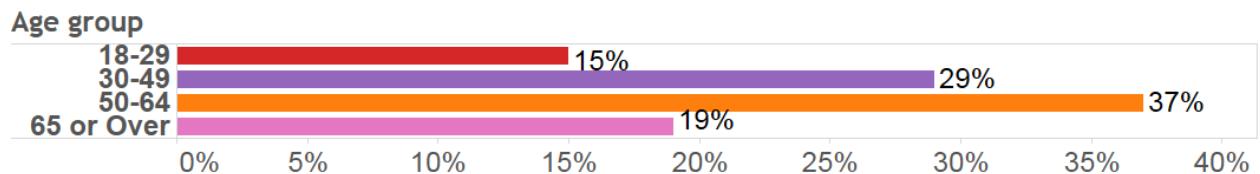
