Screener questions

S1. Are you 18 or older and registered to vote in Colorado?

- Yes100% **Continue interview**
- No -- **Terminate interview**
- Don’t know / not sure **Don’t read** -- **Terminate interview**

S2. Will you definitely vote in the November election for President, probably vote, are the chances 50-50, or will you probably not vote?

- Definitely vote 87% **Continue**
- Probably vote 10% **Continue**
- 50-50 chances..... 3% **Continue**
- Probably not vote -- **Terminate**
- Don’t know / not sure **Don’t read** -- **Terminate**

3. If the election for President were held today would you vote for Democrat Hillary Clinton, Republican Donald Trump, or someone else? **Rotate order of Clinton and Trump**

If respondent says someone else ask: Would you vote for Libertarian - Gary Johnson, or the Green - Jill Stein?

If respondent says “don’t know / undecided” ask: Even though you are undecided, which way do you lean – Democrat Hillary Clinton, Republican Donald Trump, or someone else?

This poll data is based on a random sample of 602 live-interviewer telephone surveys, including cell-phone interviews, among likely November 2016 voters statewide in Colorado. The interviews were conducted from September 27-29, 2016 by Keating Research. The worst case margin of error at the 95% level for the total sample of 602 is plus or minus 4.0%.
