

# MISSOURI STATEWIDE PUBLIC OPINION SURVEY

## 2016

Survey conducted March 25 – March 26, 2016. 927 likely voters participated in the survey. Survey weighted to match expected turnout demographics for the 2016 General Election. Margin of Error is +/- 3.2%. Margins of Error within specific demographics (crosstabs) is significantly higher due to smaller sample size. Totals do not always equal 100% due to rounding. Survey conducted by Remington Research Group on behalf of Missouri Scout.
