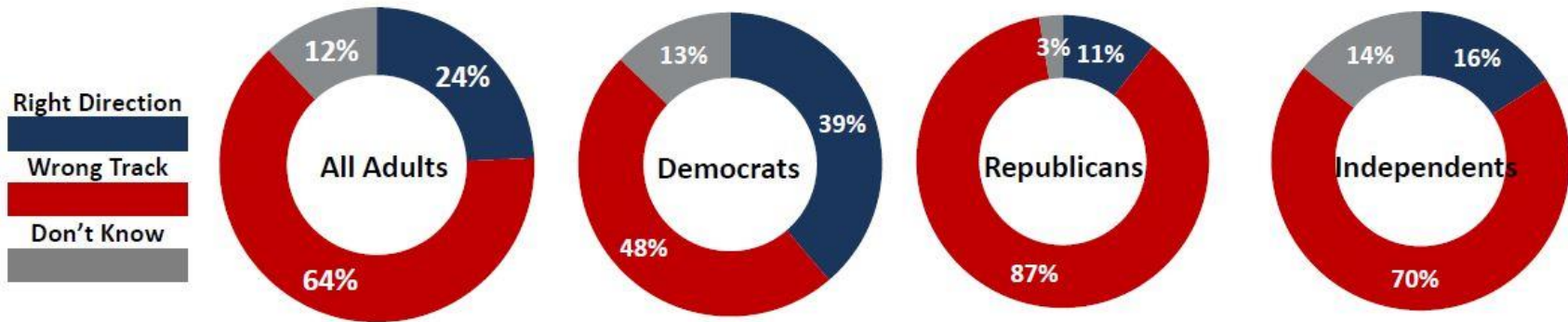

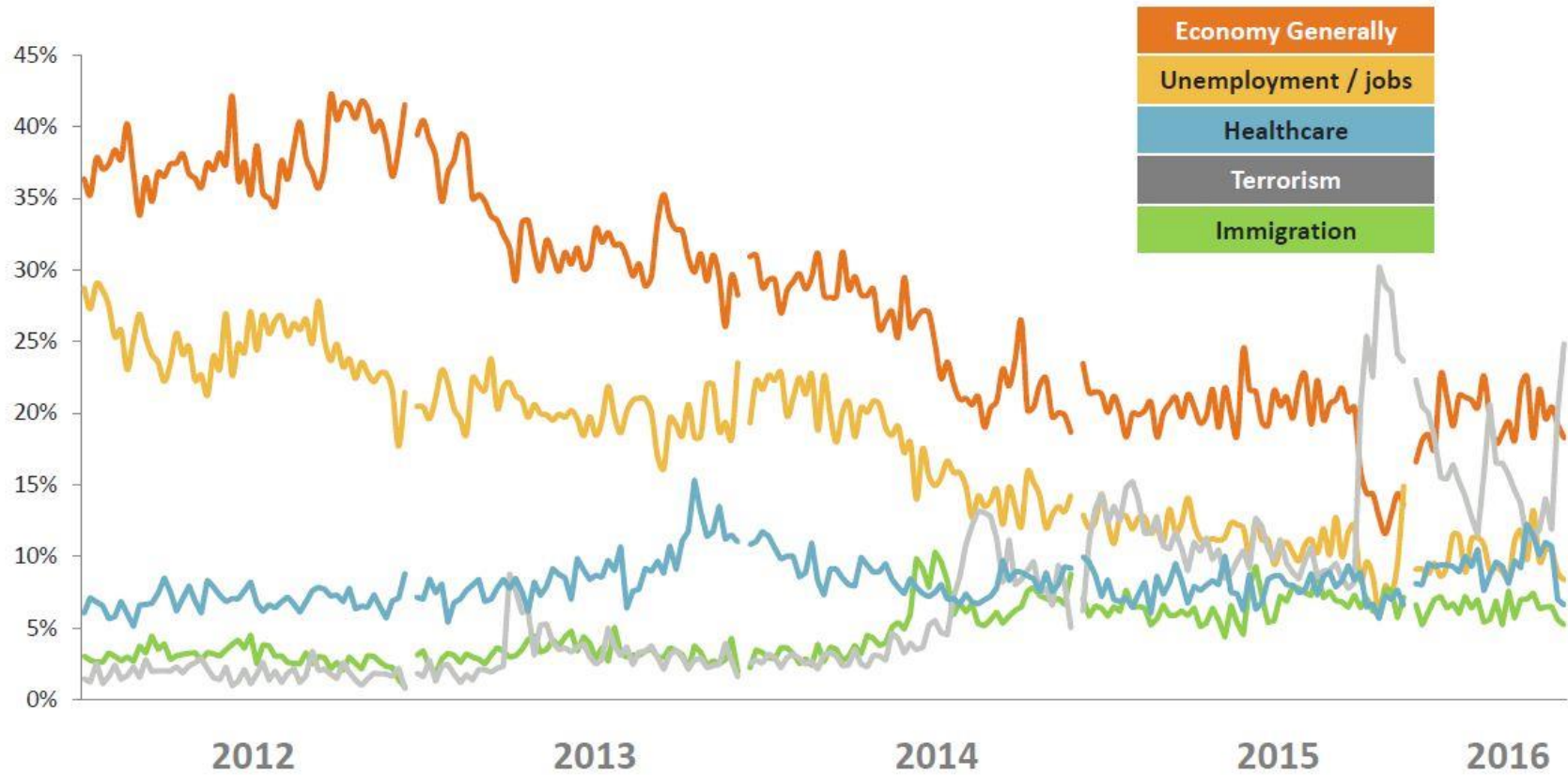

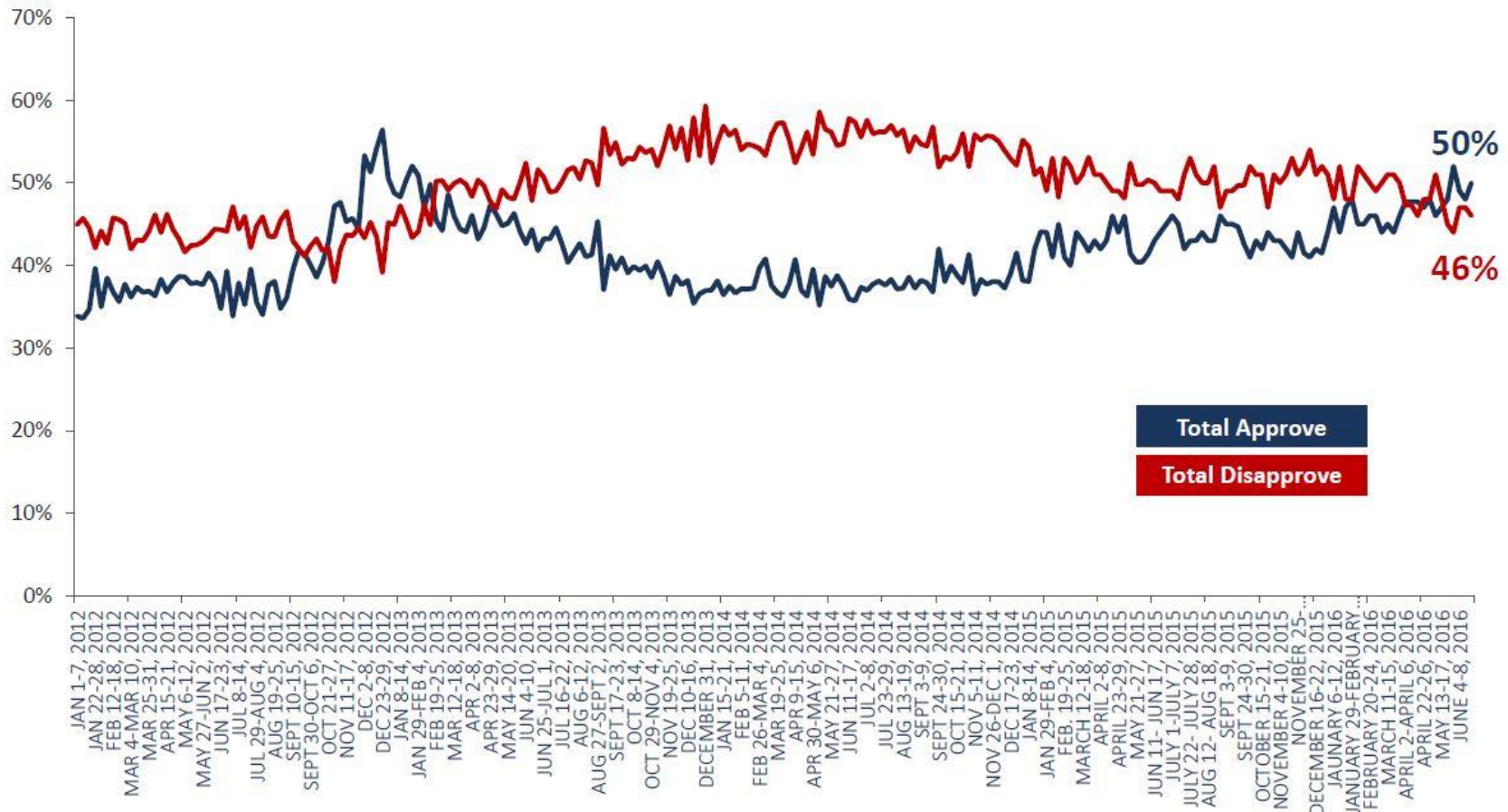
Overall, do you approve or disapprove about the way Barack Obama is handling his job as President?

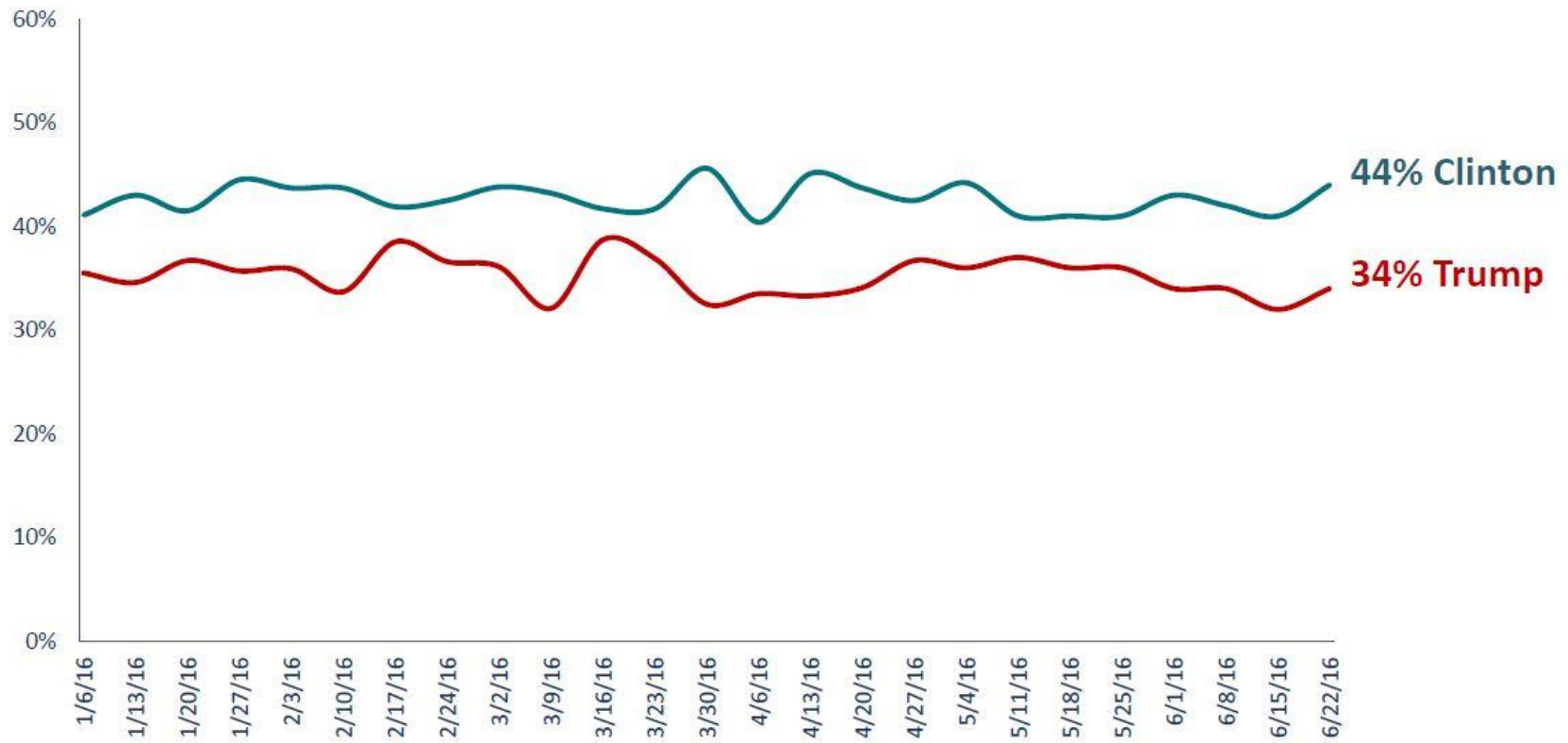
