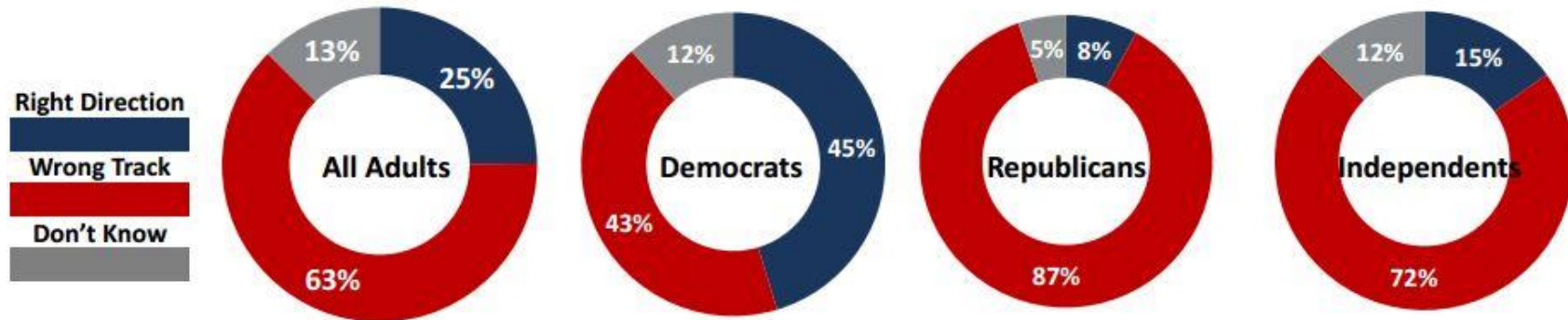


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Right Direction/Wrong Track



Generally speaking, would you say things in this country are heading in the right direction, or are they off on the wrong track?

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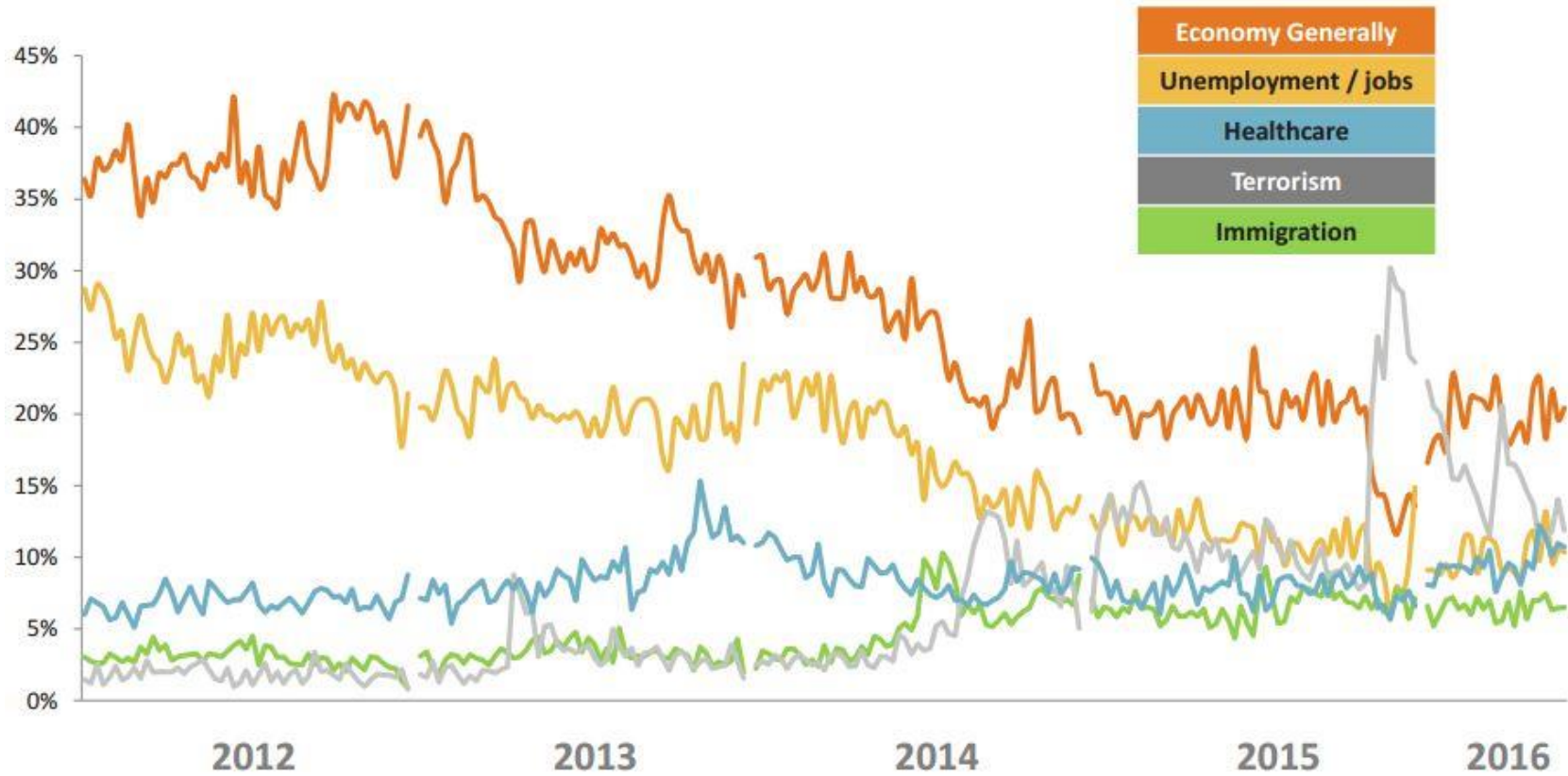
Main Problem Facing America

| Terrorism / terrorist attacks | 12% | 12% | 14% | 9% |
| Healthcare | 11% | 12% | 11% | 6% |

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Barack Obama



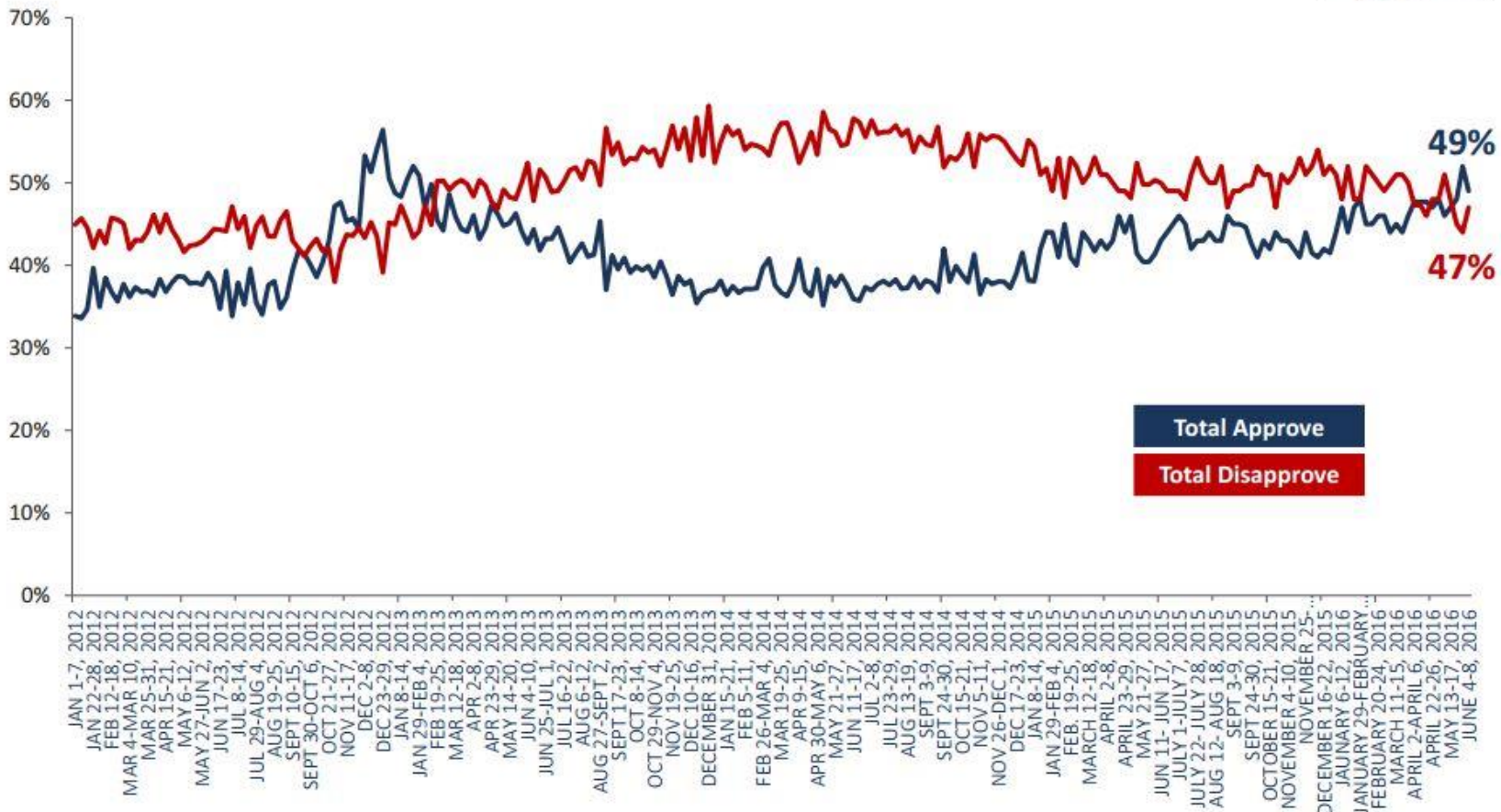
Overall, do you approve or disapprove about the way Barack Obama is handling his job as President?

| Strongly approve | 27% | 51% | 4% | 16% |
| Somewhat approve | 19% | 29% | 9% | 15% |
| Lean towards approve | 3% | 3% | 1% | 5% |
| Lean towards disapprove | 2% | 1% | 1% | 3% |
| Somewhat disapprove | 12% | 7% | 20% | 18% |
| Strongly disapprove | 33% | 7% | 65% | 36% |
| Not sure | 4% | 1% | 1% | 7% |
| TOTAL APPROVE | 49% | 84% | 14% | 36% |
| TOTAL DISAPPROVE | 47% | 15% | 86% | 58% |

Democratic Presidential Primaries

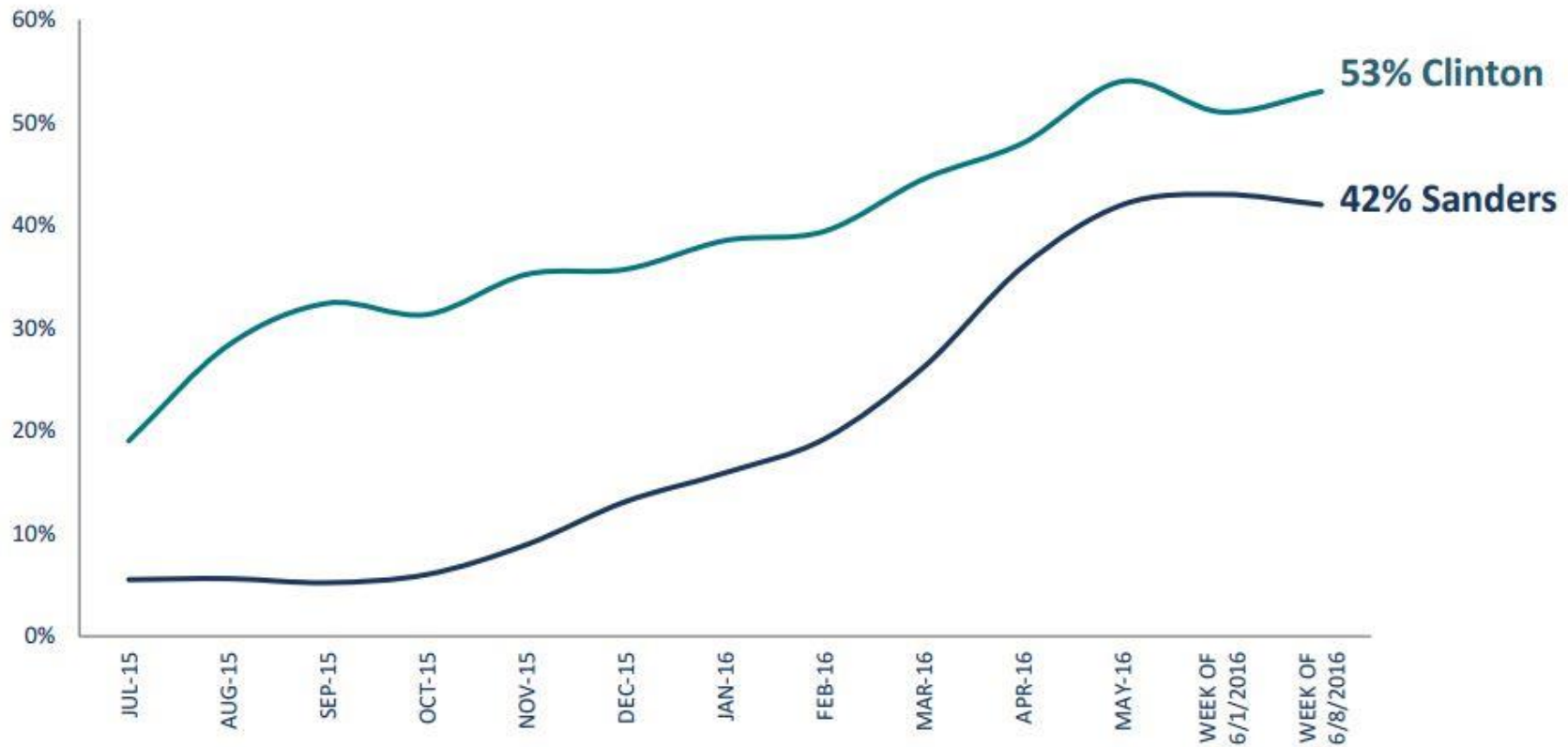

| Wouldn't vote | 10% | 4% | 21% |

General Head-to-Heads

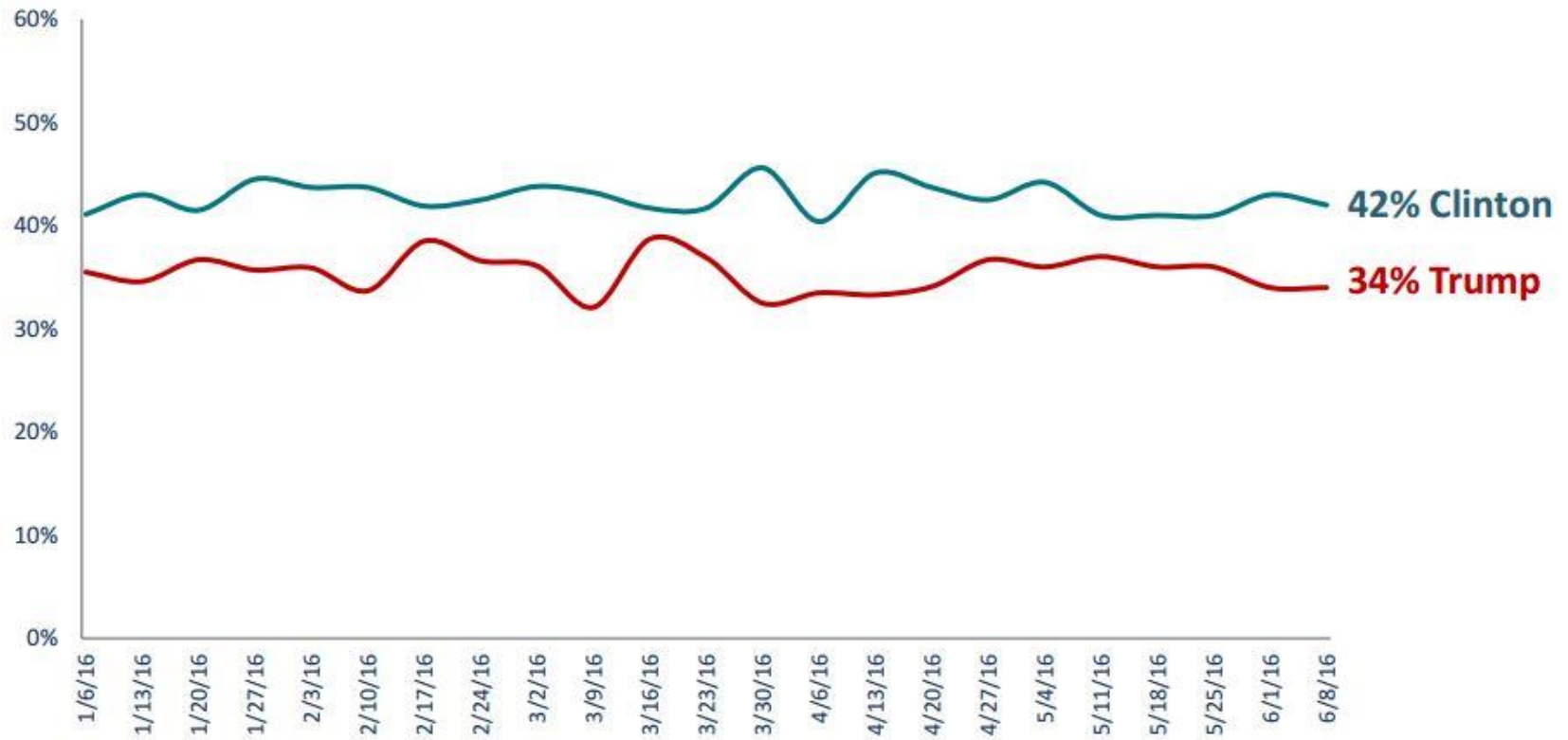
If the 2016 presidential election were being held today and the candidates were as below, for whom would you vote?

| Hillary Clinton (Democrat) | 42% | 74% | 8% | 29% |
| Donald Trump (Republican) | 34% | 8% | 71% | 33% |
| Neither / Other | 12% | 8% | 13% | 21% |
| Wouldn't Vote | 5% | 6% | 2% | 7% |
| Don't know / Refused | 6% | 4% | 6% | 10% |
