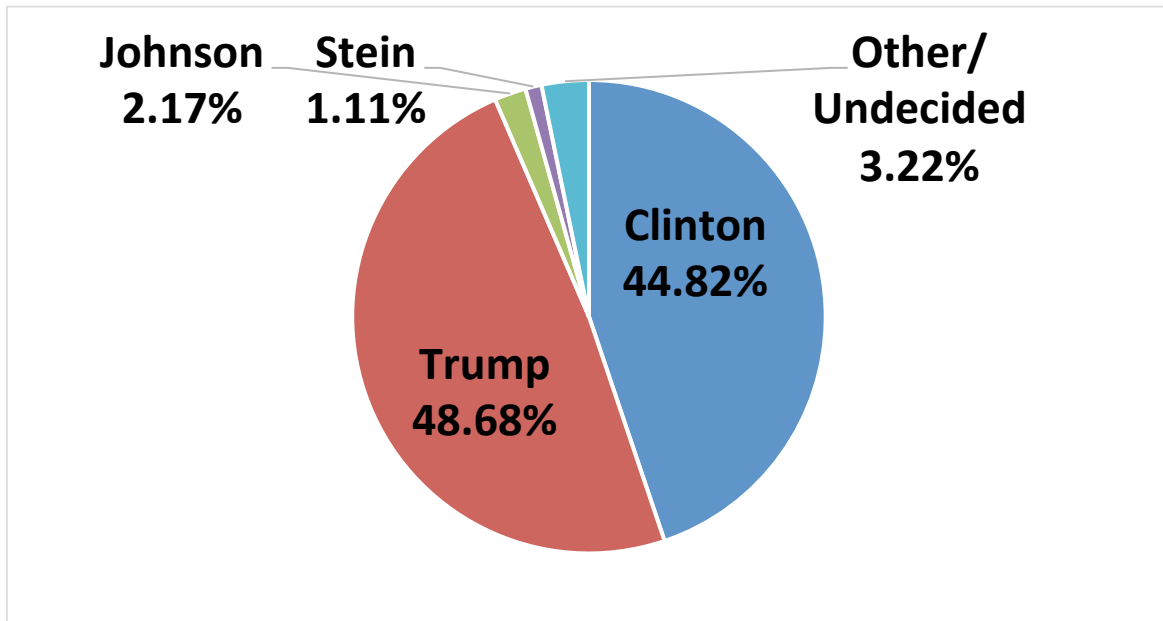

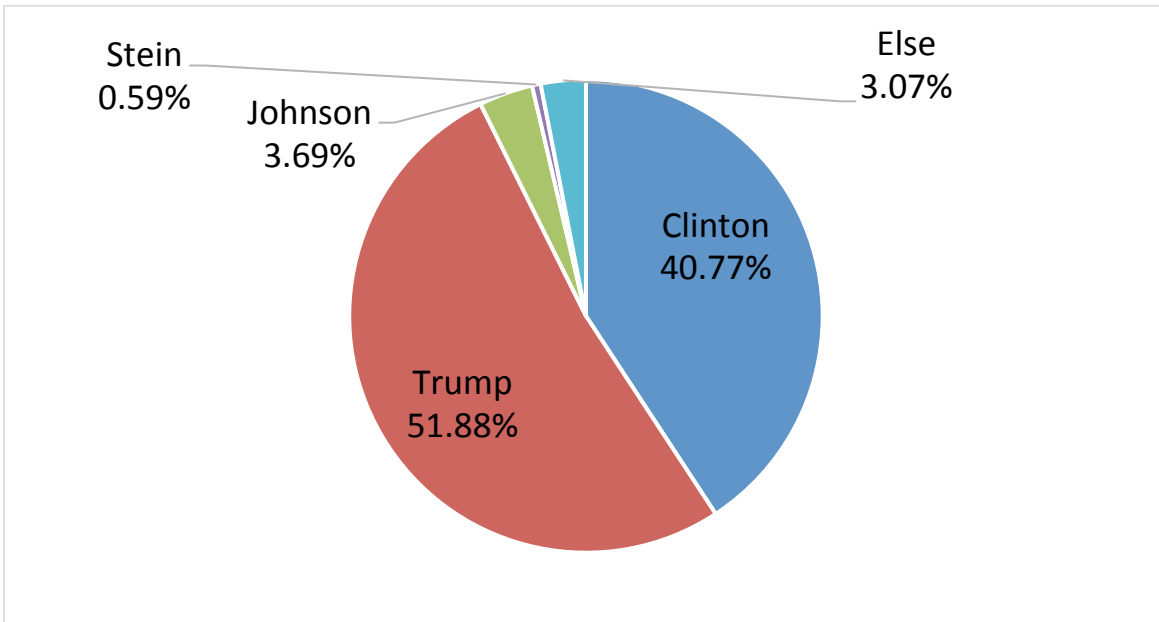

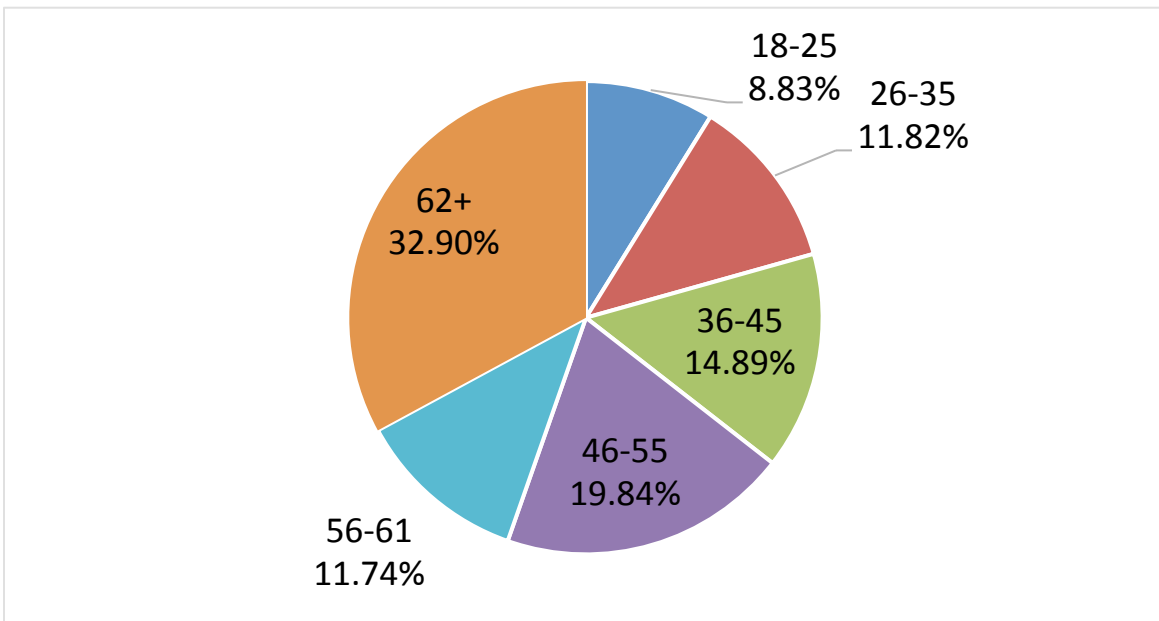
If the election were held today, for whom would you vote?



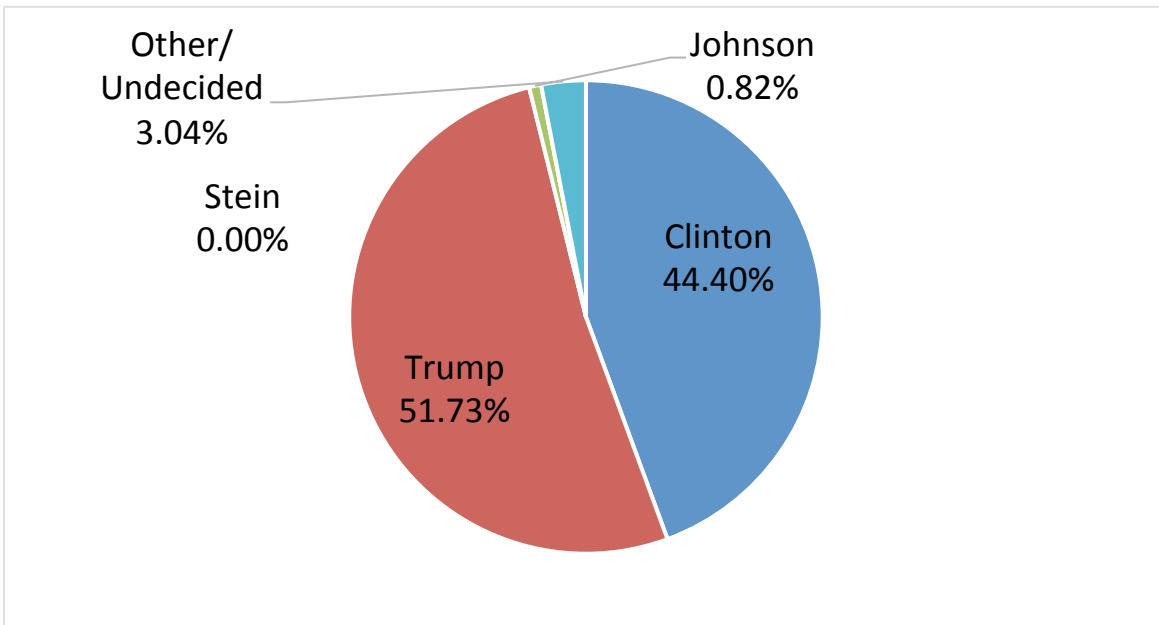
Which candidate do you think most of your neighbors are voting for?



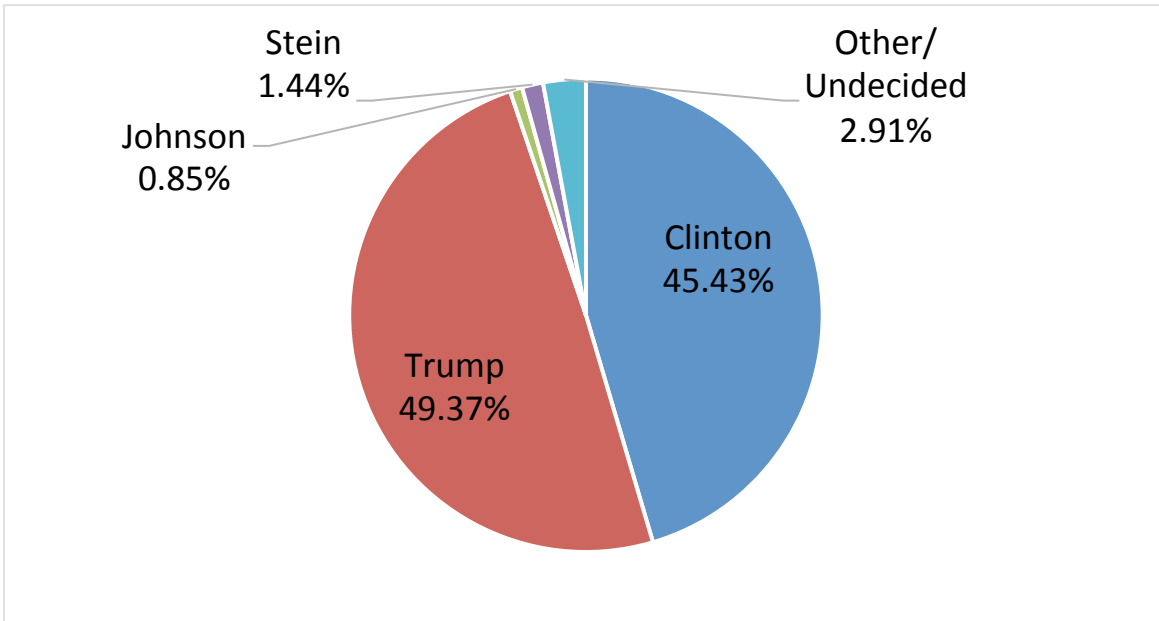

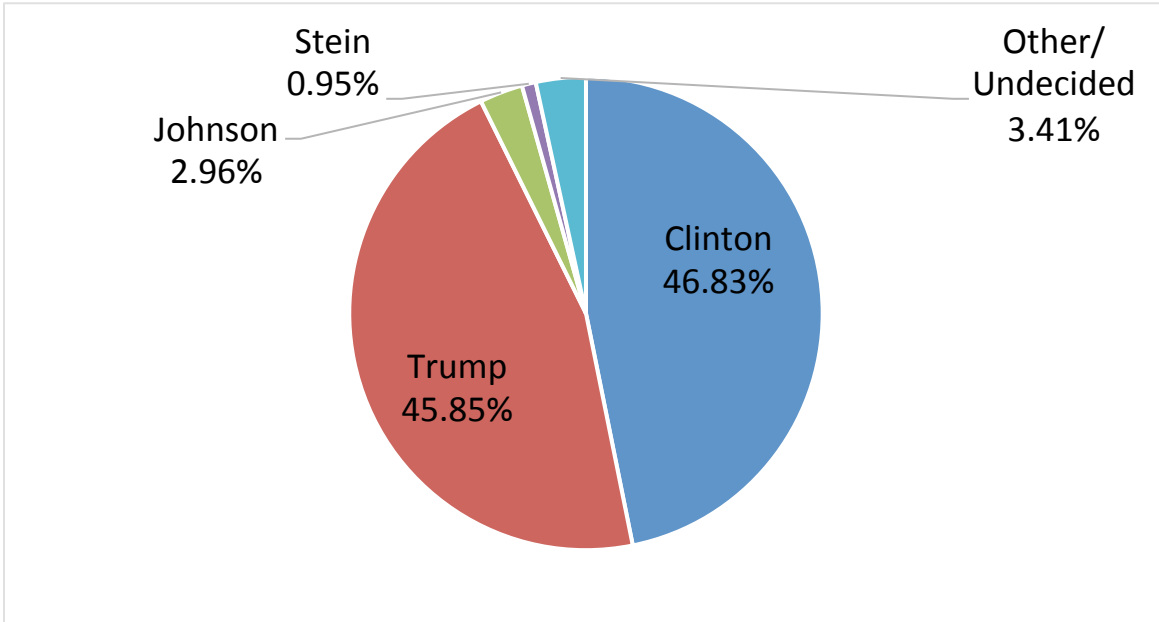

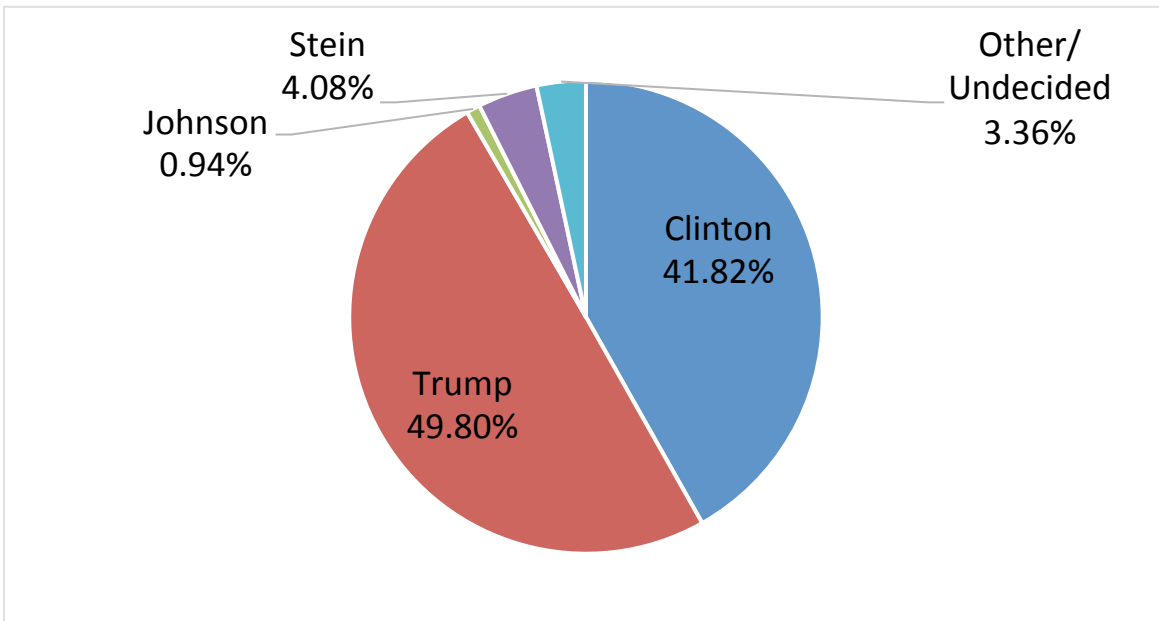

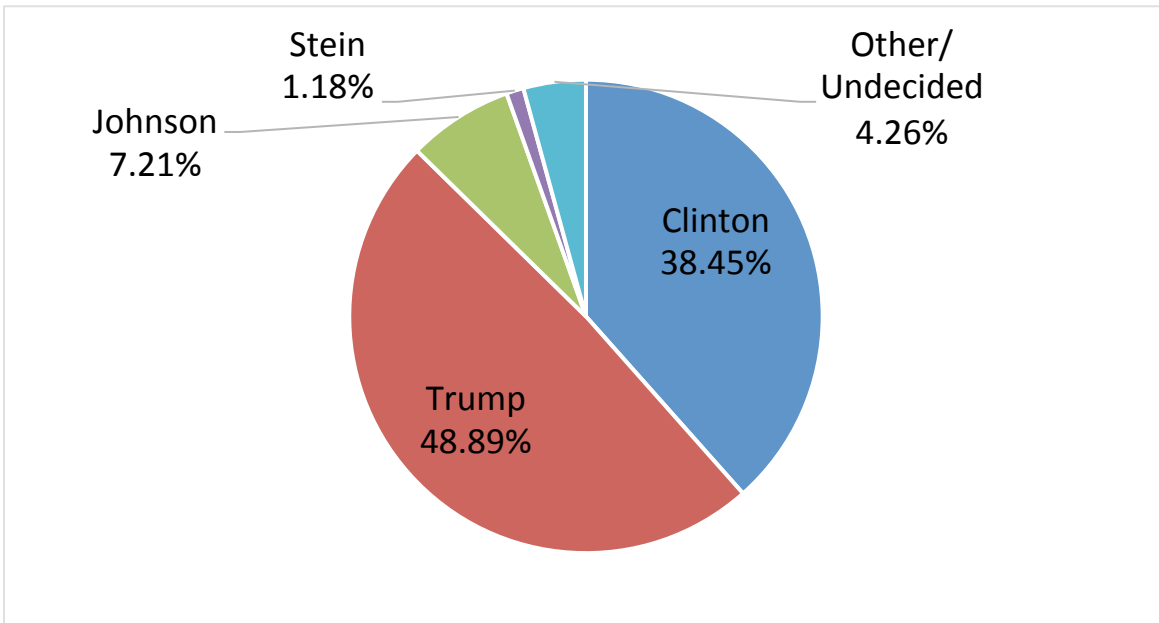

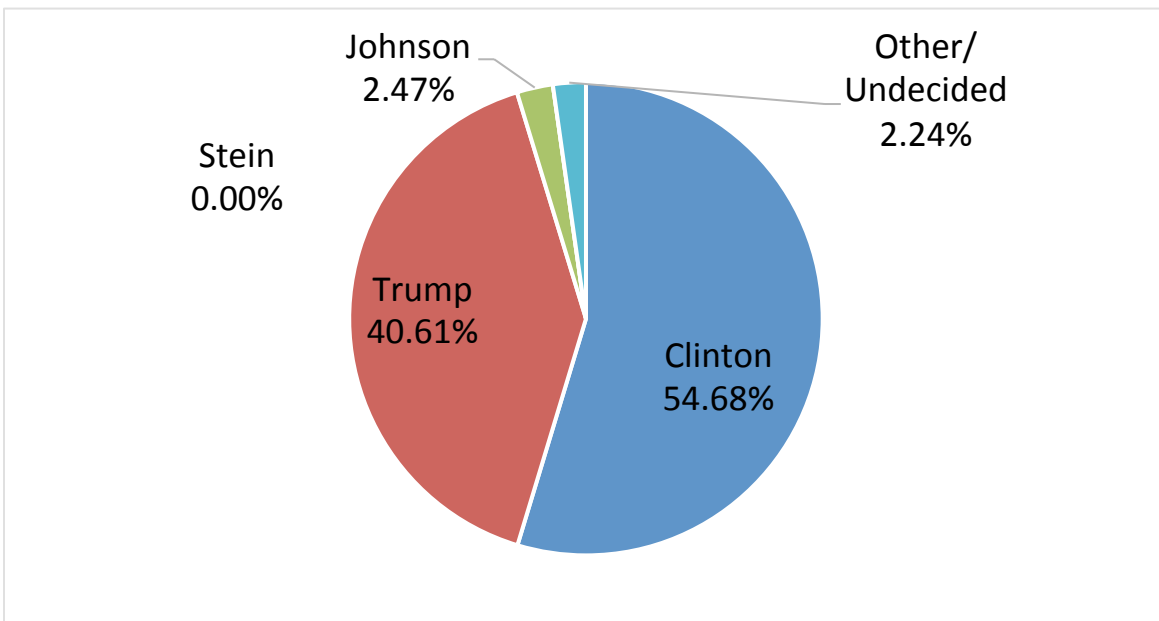

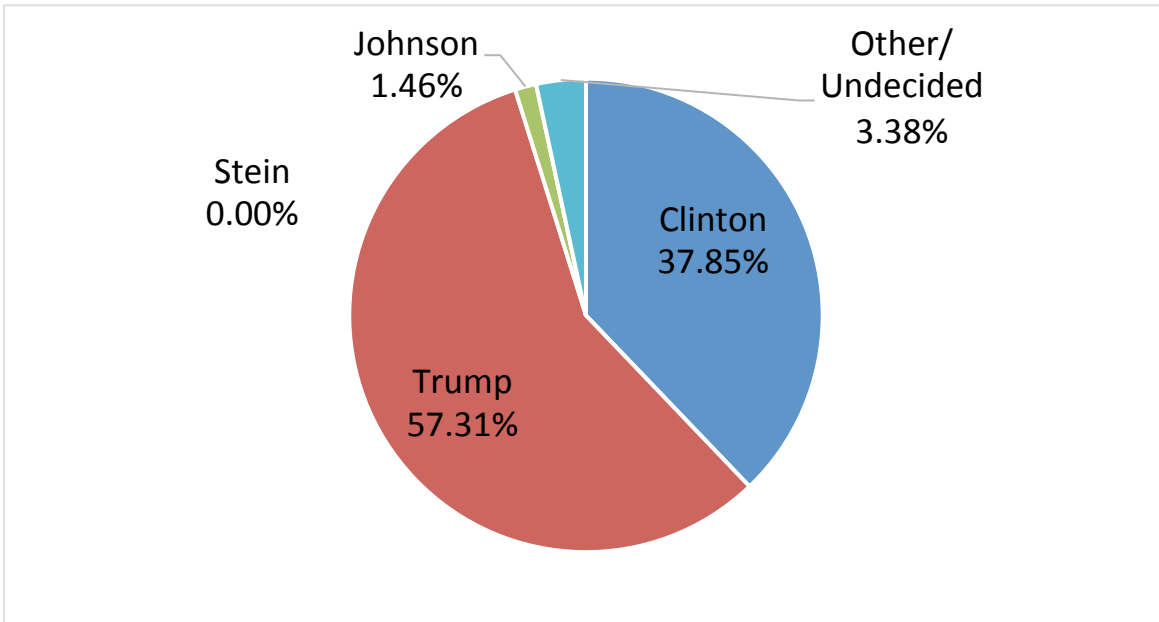

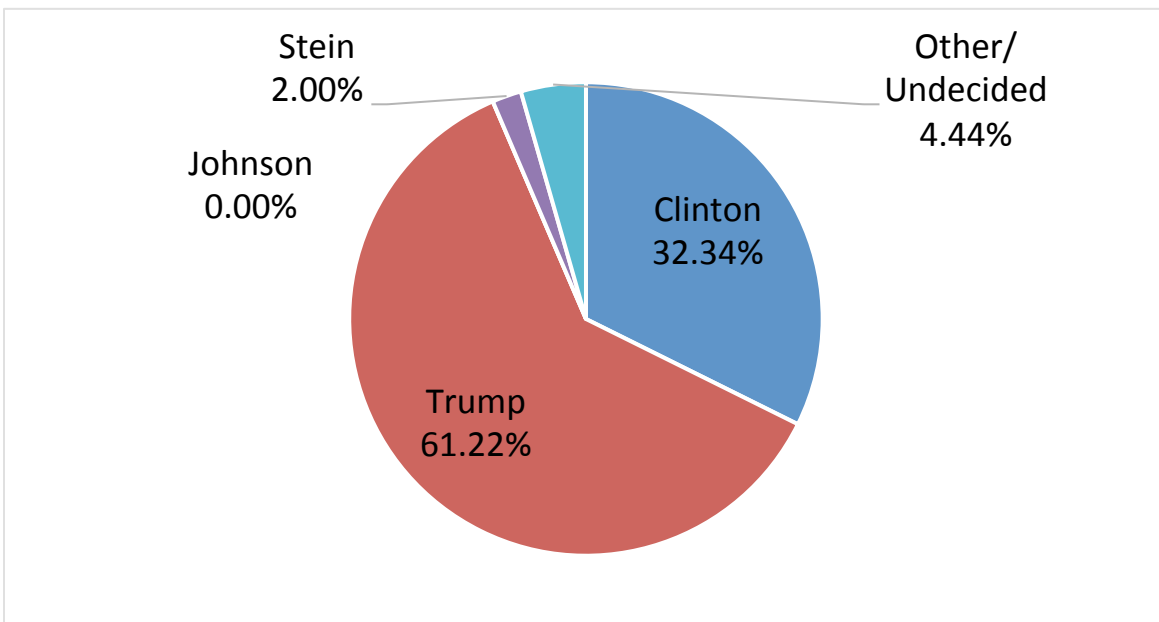

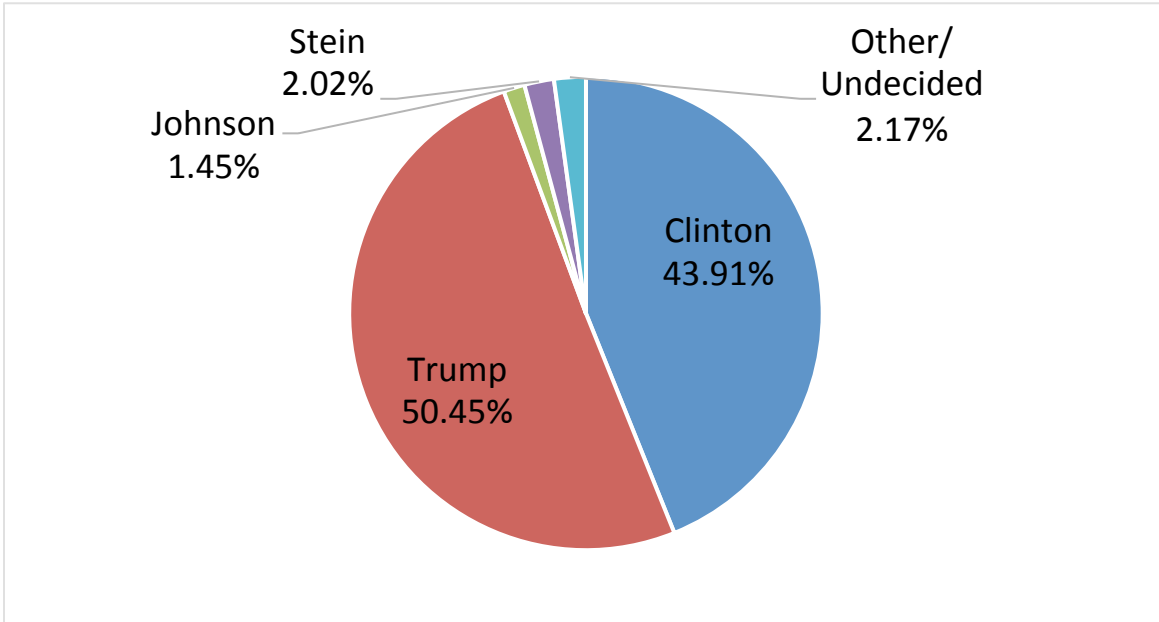

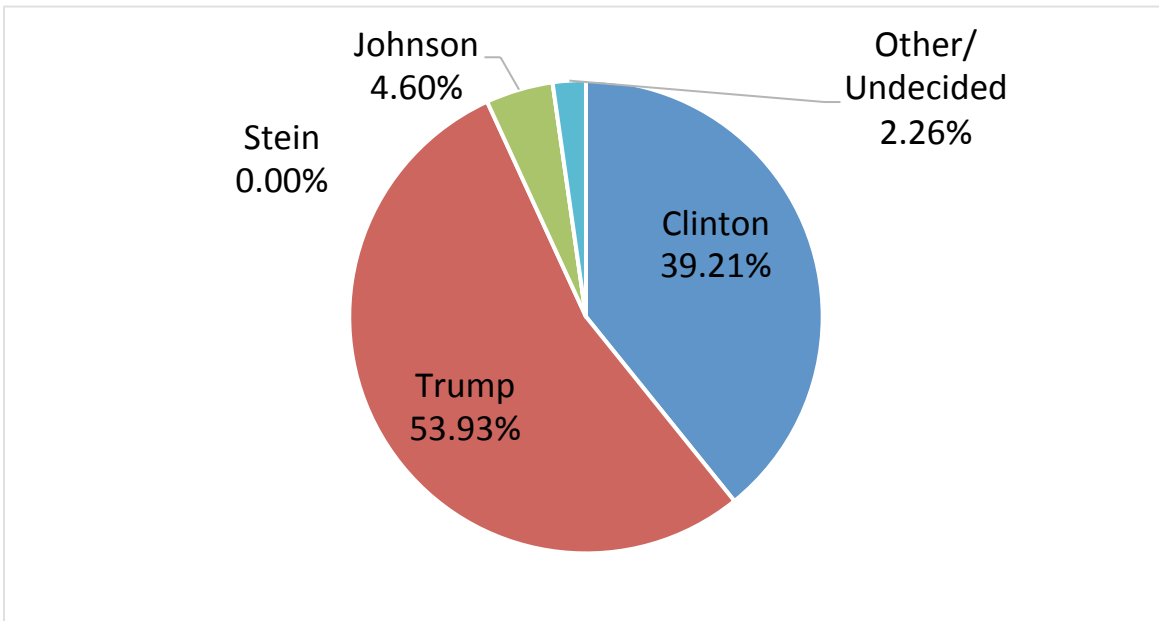

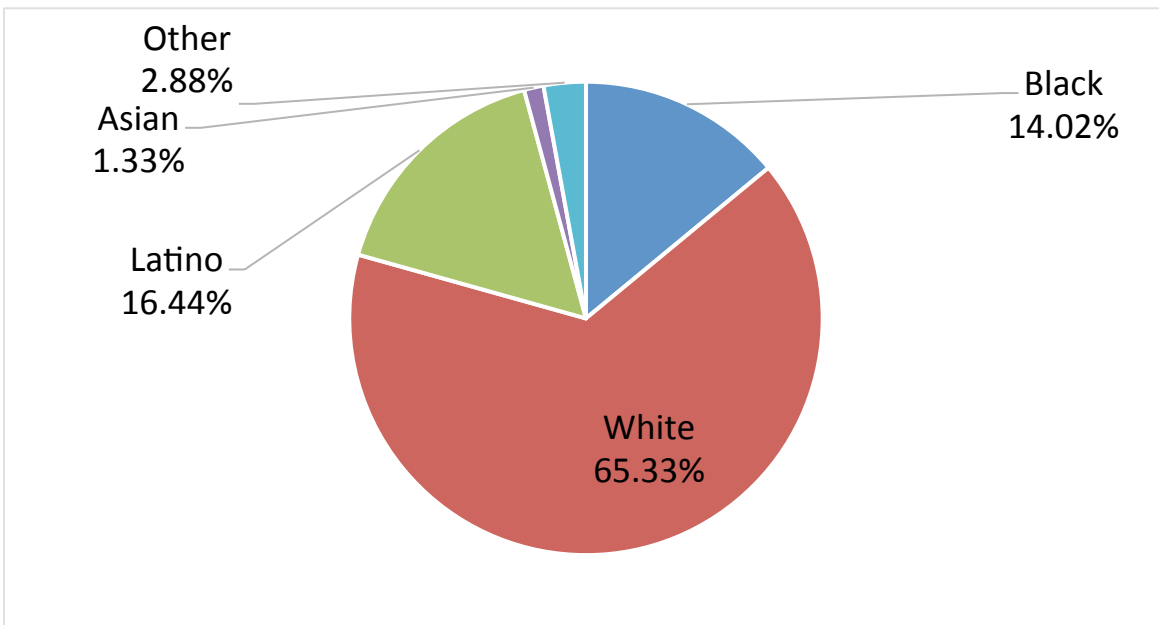

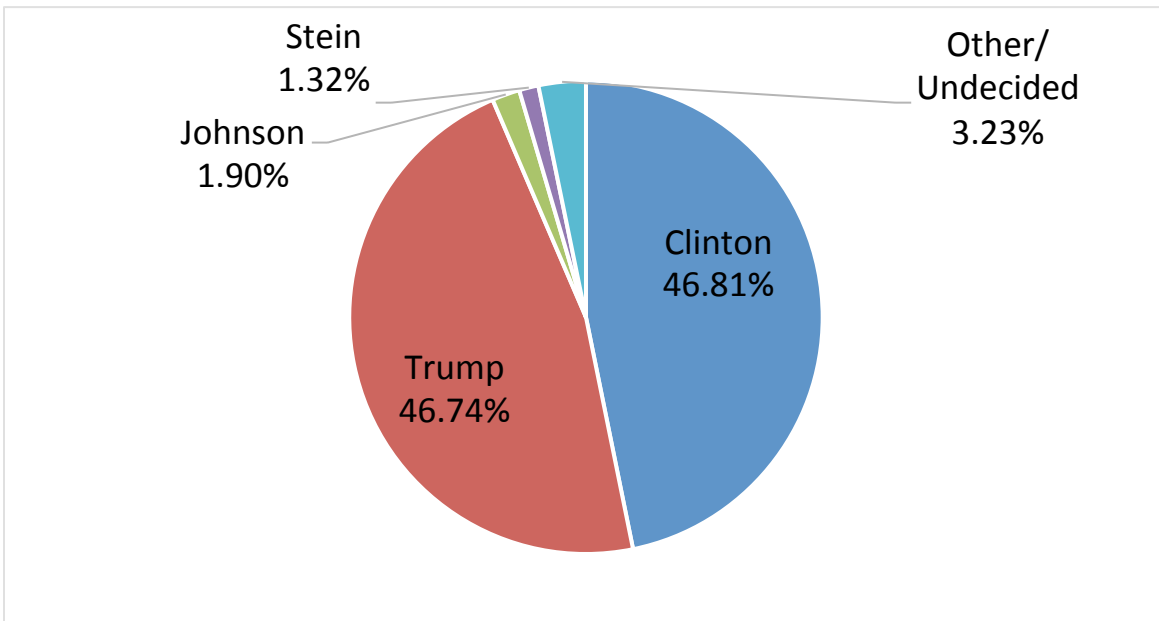
Self-Identified Gender



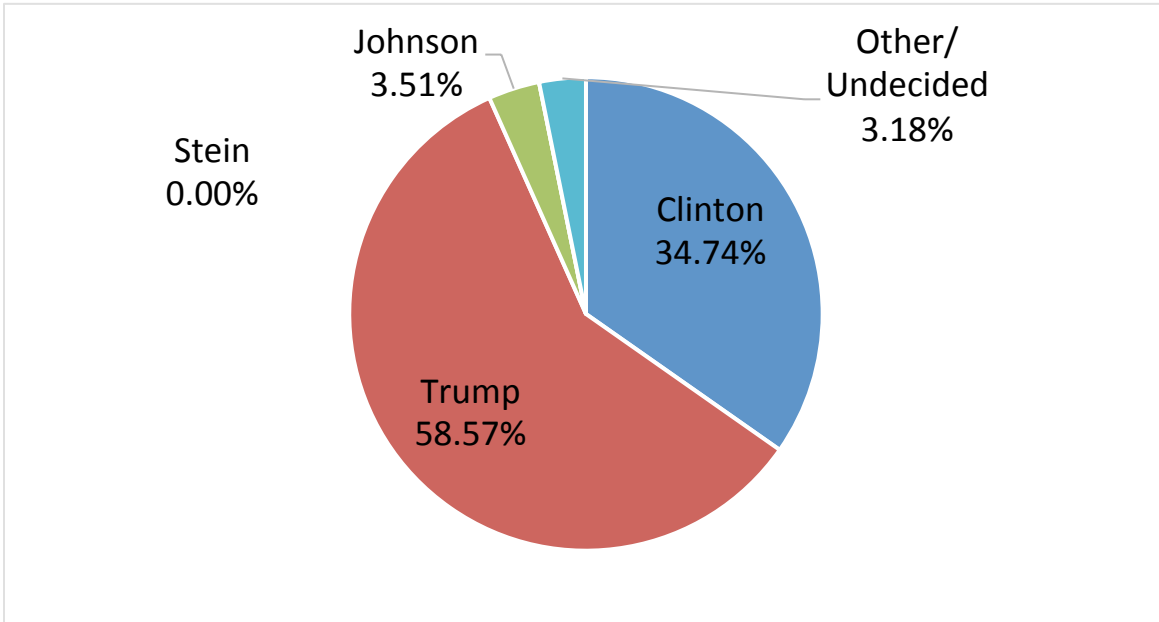

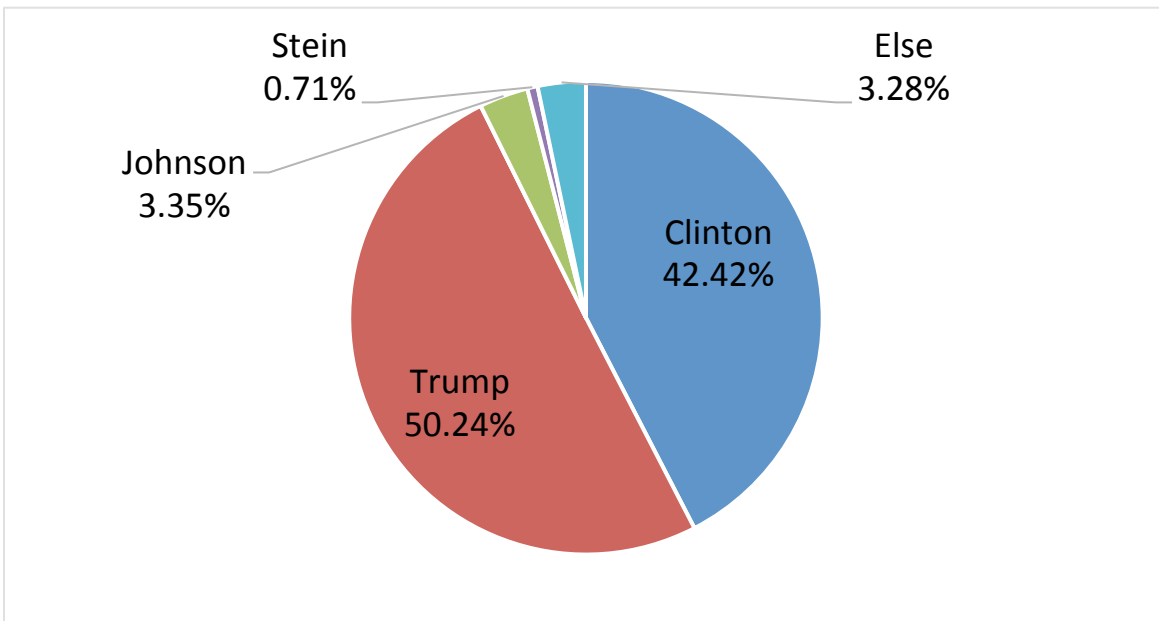
Survey Question #1 Likely voters whose most recent general election was 2008 and forward

general election was 2006 and before

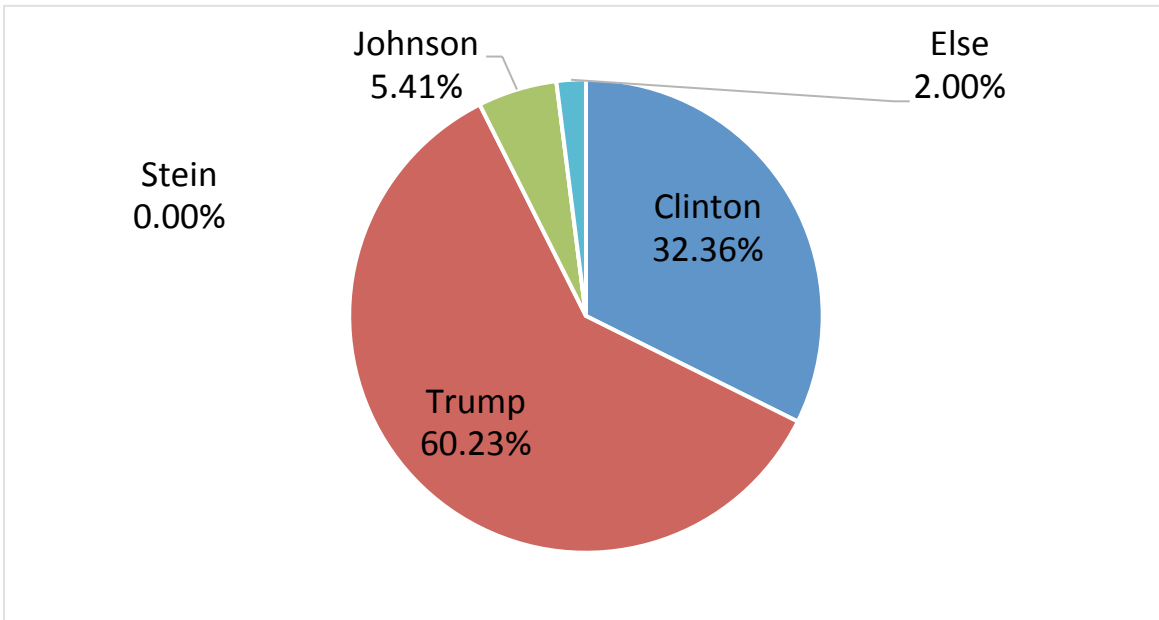


Survey Question #2

Methodology

Likely general election voters were selected at random from a list of registered voters based on election participation and registration date. Household ages and locations were extracted as well from this list. In excess of 50,000 households were called over the duration of the poll. Each household participant was asked to opt-in to the survey if they planned to vote in the 2016 Presidential Election.

Using automated voice response technology allows each participant to hear the questions exactly the same way, from the same voice, spoken with the same tone and nuance. Calls are placed to randomly-selected phone numbers through a stratified process that insures appropriate geographic representation. These calls were placed from 6:00pm to 8:30pm local time from Thursday, October 27th through Monday, October 31st.

Survey results undergo a weighting process to ensure the sample is comparable to the demographic breakdown of 2012 Florida general election participants. Final results are based on these weights in order to address non-response bias.
