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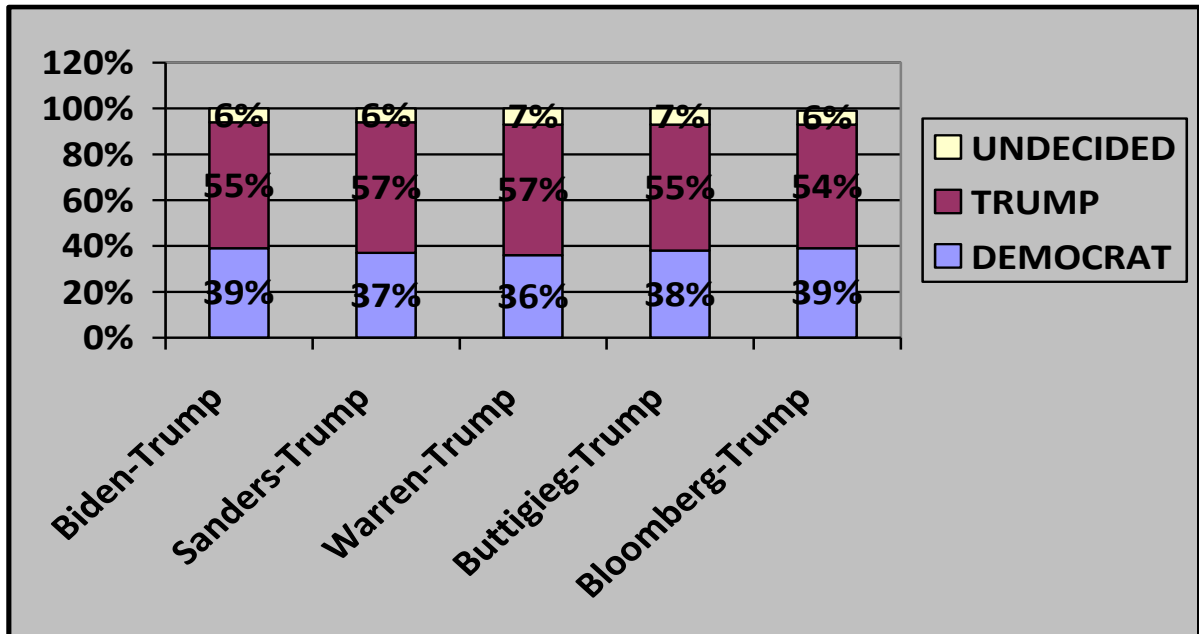
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TRUMP RUNNING STRONG IN TENNESSEE HOLDS WIDE LEADS OVER ALL TOP DEMOCRATS

President Donald Trump is solidly positioned to again carry Tennessee in his run for reelection. Statewide, when matched against the leading Democratic contenders Trump draws 55-57% of the vote in all instances and none of the Democrats draws support that crosses over the 40% threshold.

2020 PRESIDENTIAL VOTE



Trump leads Joe Biden 55%-39%, Bernie Sanders 57%-37%, Elizabeth Warren 57%-36%, Pete Buttigieg 55%-38% and Michael Bloomberg 54%-39%. Tennessee has voted Republican in every presidential race since 2000 and there is no evidence that will change in 2020.

HOW THE POLL WAS CONDUCTED

This poll was conducted by Mason-Dixon Polling & Research, Inc. of Jacksonville, Florida from January 28 through January 30, 2020. A total of 625 registered Tennessee voters were interviewed live by telephone statewide.

Those interviewed were randomly selected from a phone-matched Tennessee voter registration list that included both land-line and cell phone numbers. Quotas were assigned to reflect voter registration by county.

The margin for error, according to standards customarily used by statisticians, is no more than ± 4 percentage points. This means that there is a 95 percent probability that the "true" figure would fall within that range if all voters were surveyed. The margin for error is higher for any subgroup, such as a gender or age grouping.
