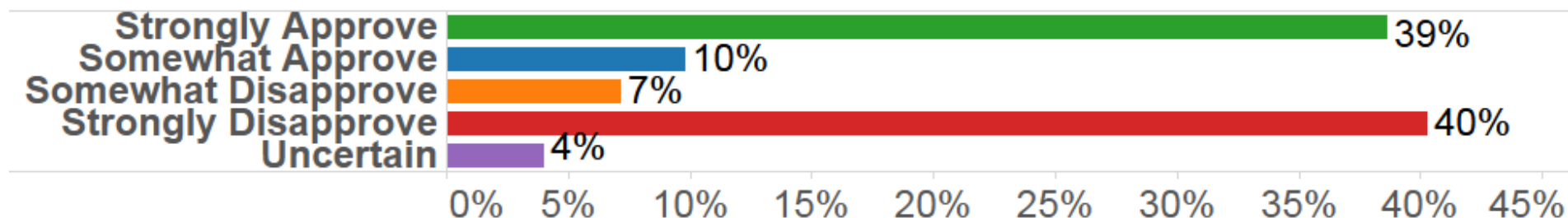

Executive Summary

Gravis Marketing, a nonpartisan research firm, conducted a random survey of 1,840 likely voters across Florida. The poll was conducted from July 13th through the 14th and has a margin of error of $\pm 2.3\%$. The totals may not round to 100% because of rounding. The survey was conducted using an online panel of cell phone users and interactive voice responses. The results are weighted by voting demographics.

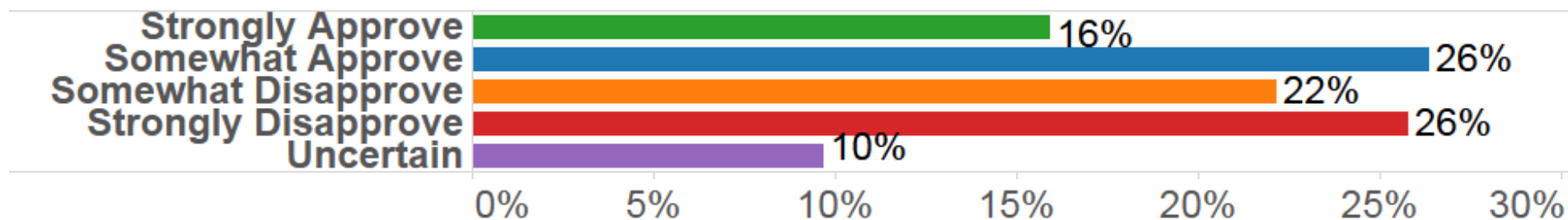
4) Do you strongly approve, somewhat approve, somewhat disapprove, or strongly disapprove of President Trump’s job performance?

Q4: TRUMP JOB PERFORMANCE



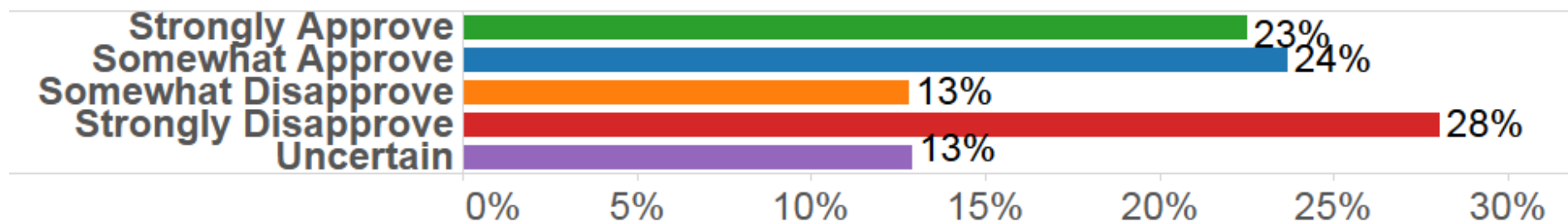
5) Do you strongly approve, somewhat approve, somewhat disapprove, or strongly disapprove of Senator Rubio’s job performance?

Q5: RUBIO JOB PERFORMANCE



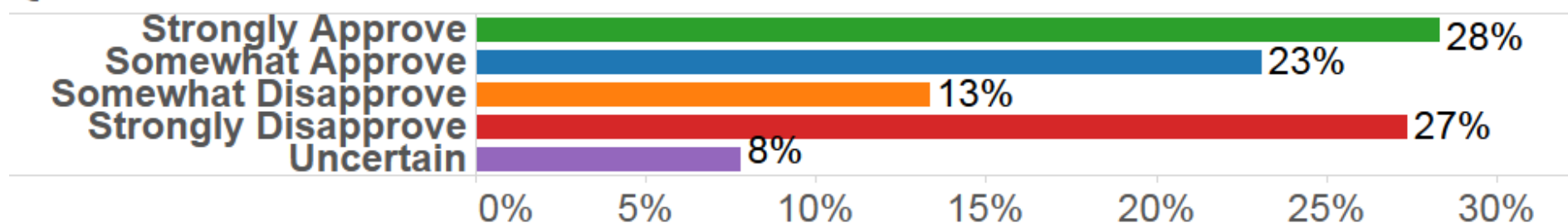
6) Do you strongly approve, somewhat approve, somewhat disapprove, or strongly disapprove of Senator Nelson's job performance?

Q6: NELSON JOB PERFORMANCE



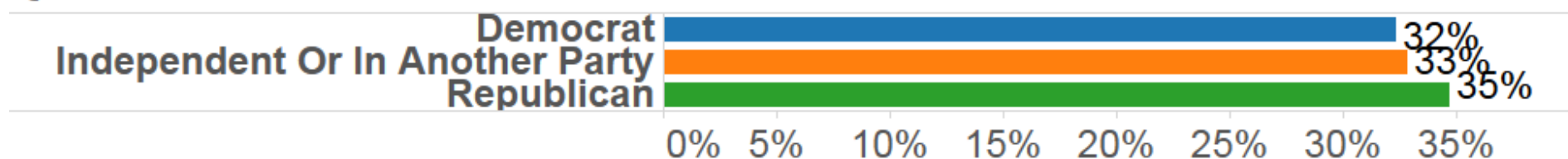
7) Do you strongly approve, somewhat approve, somewhat disapprove, or strongly disapprove of Governor Scott's job performance?

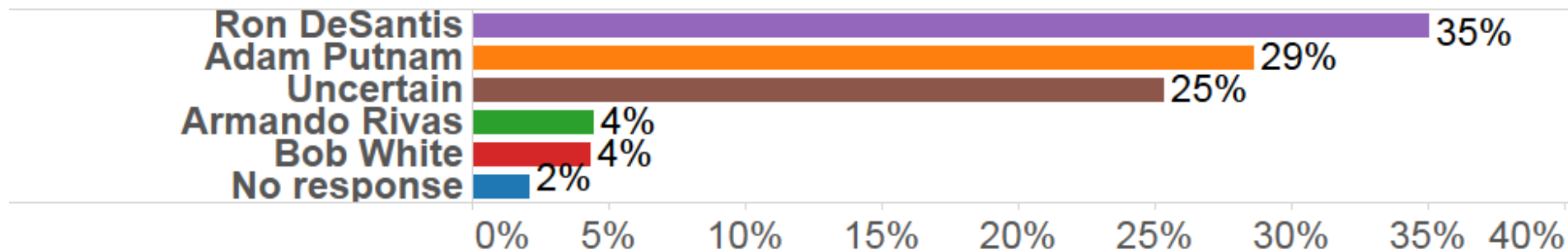

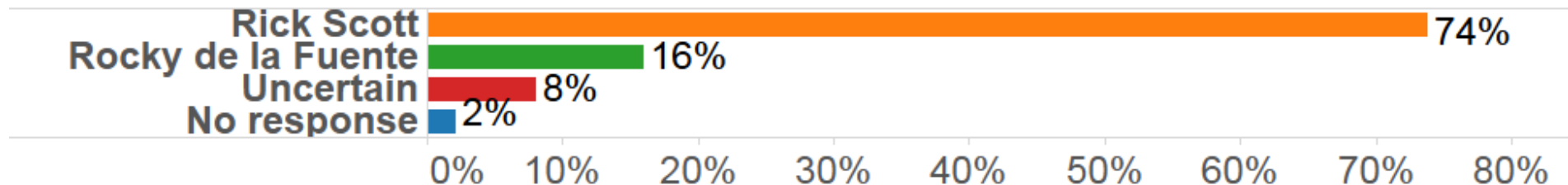
Q9: REPUBLICAN PRIMARY - GOVERNOR

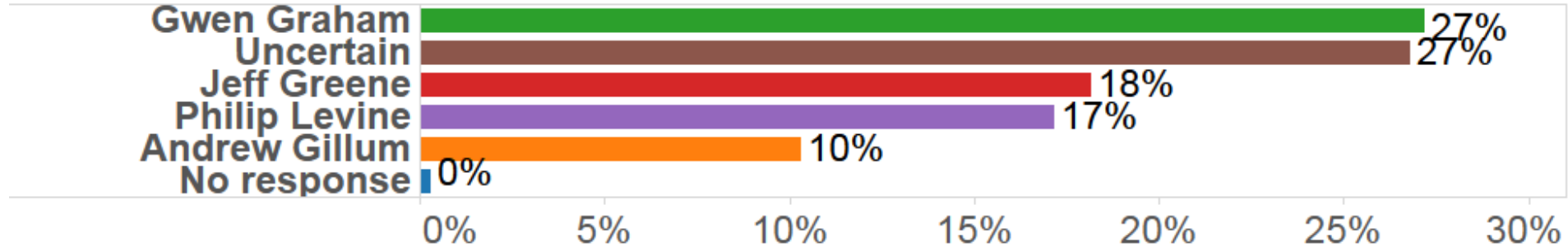

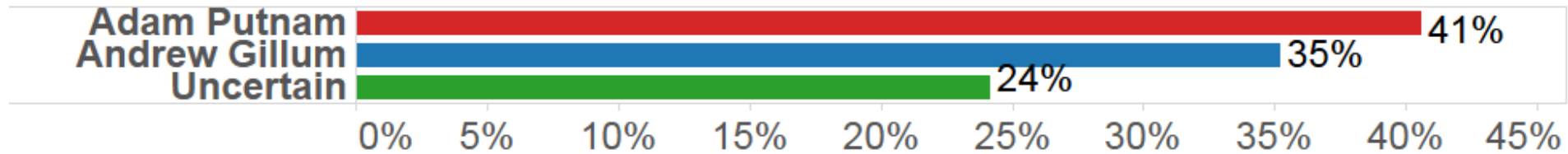

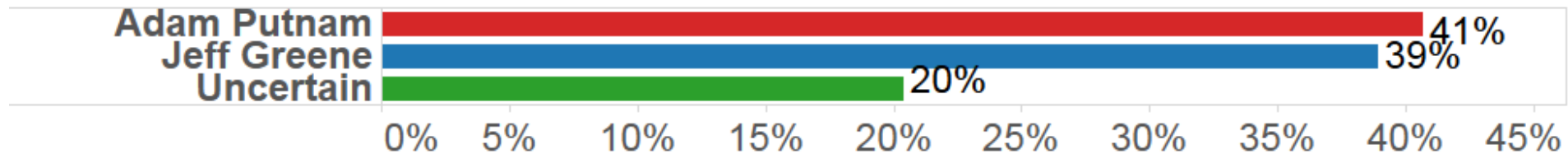

Q12: GOVERNOR



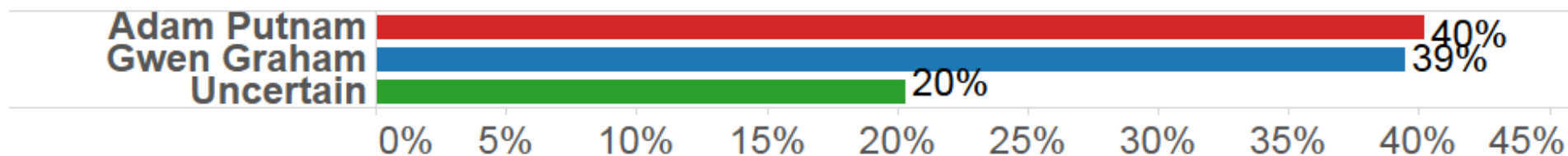
13) If the election for Governor were held today and the candidates were Adam Putnam and Jeff Greene, who would you vote for?

Q13: GOVERNOR



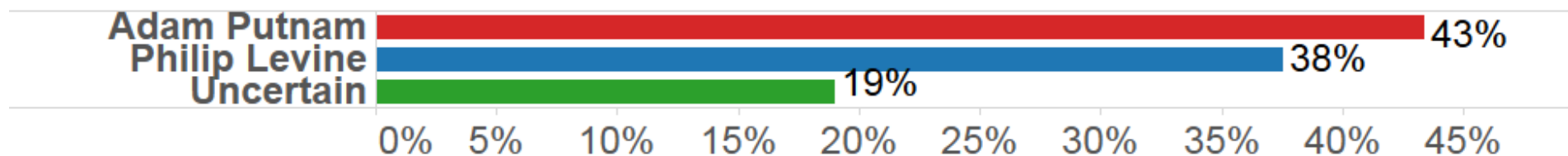

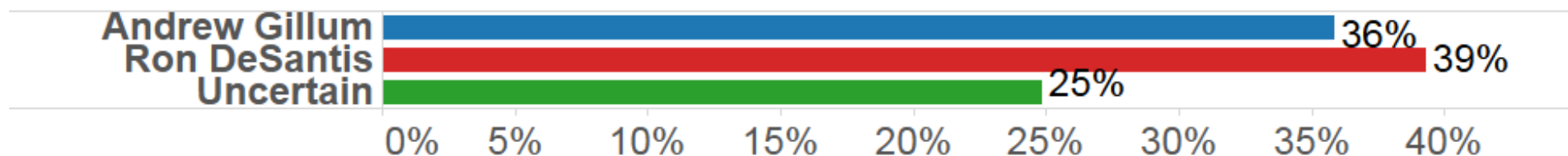

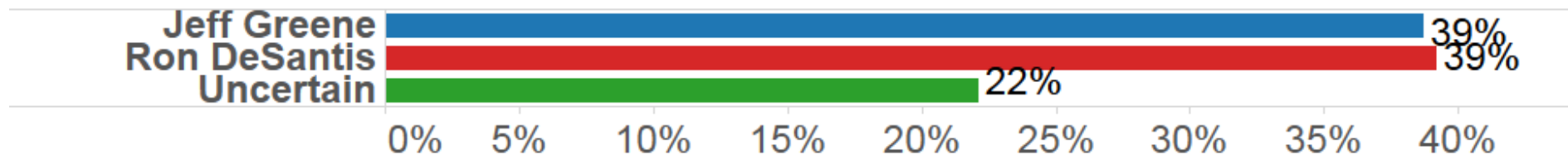

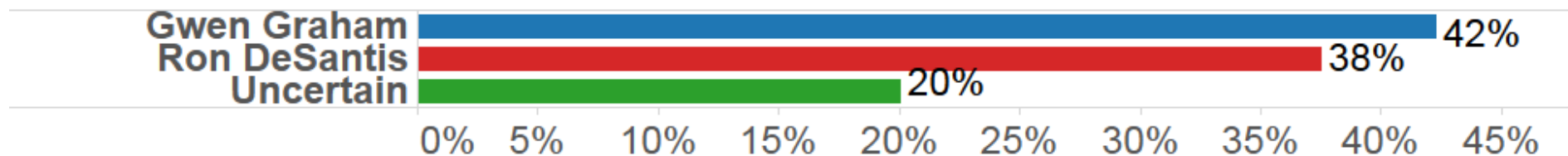

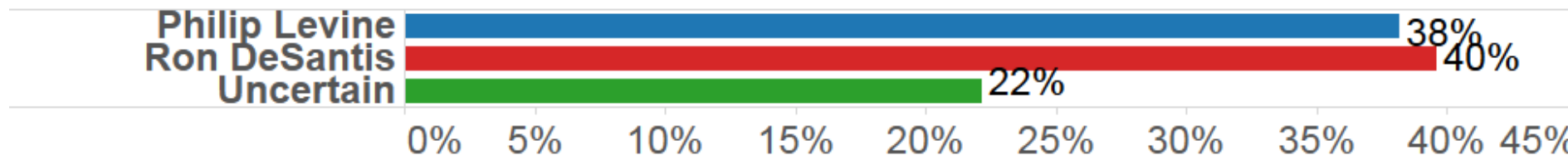

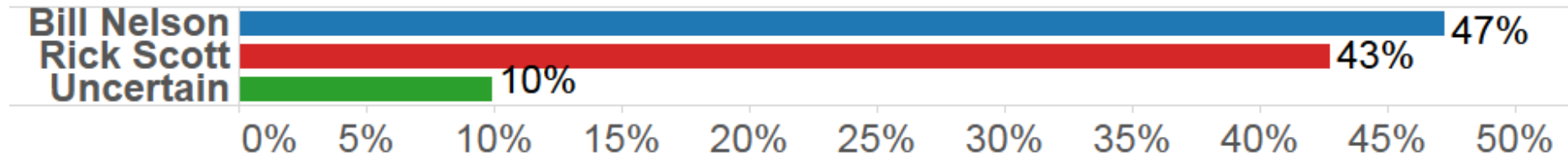

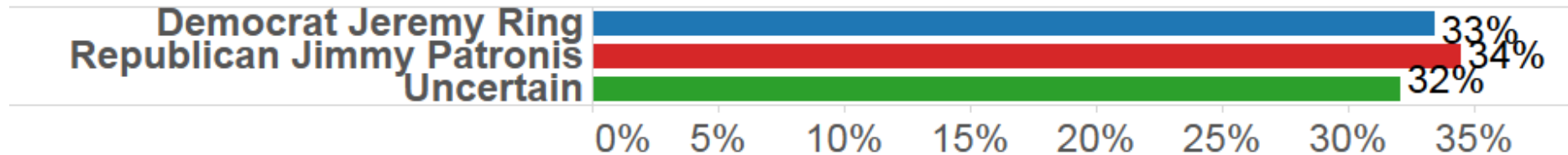

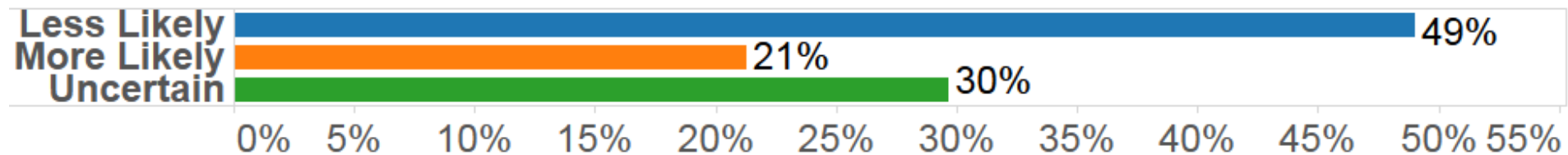

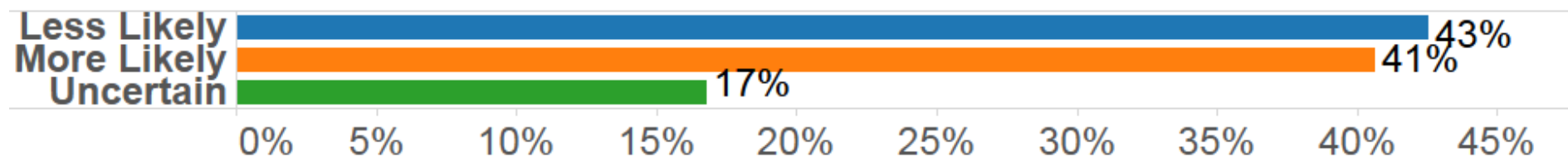
22) Would you more or less likely support a candidate for Congress if you knew they would support Nancy Pelosi to be Speaker of the House?

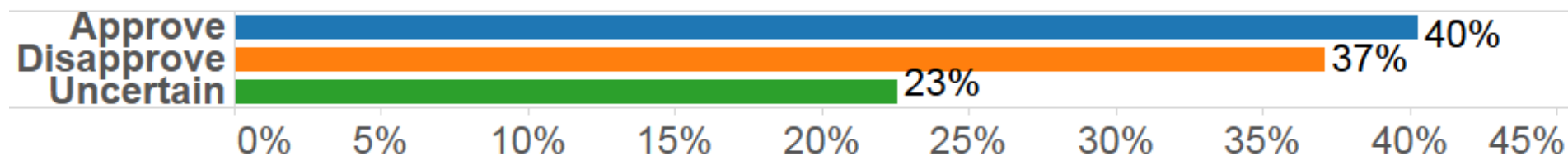

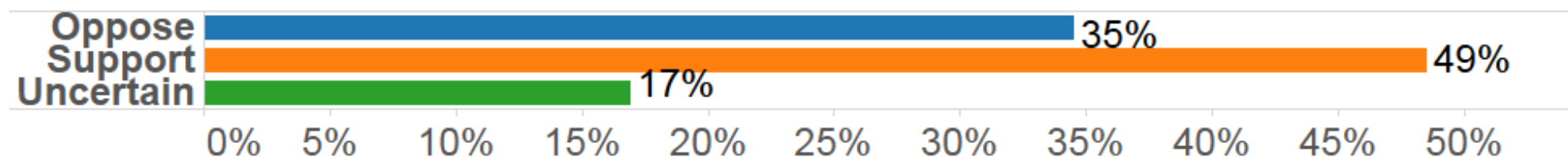

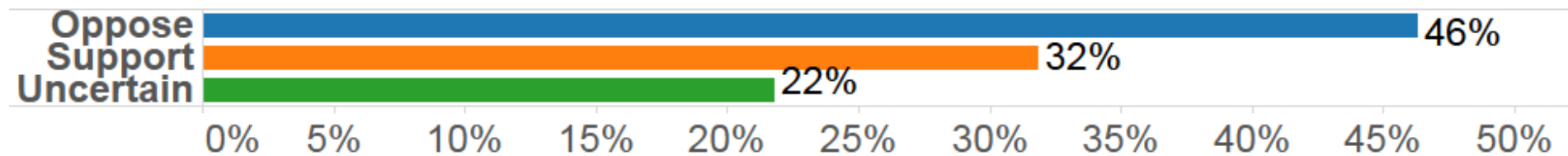
25) Do you support or oppose the legalization of same-sex marriage in the United States?

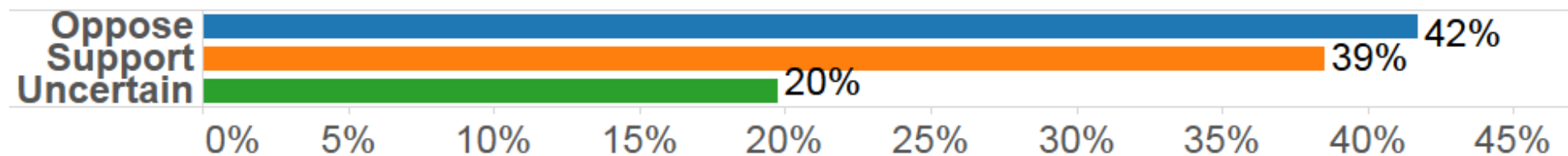
26) Do you support or oppose a ban on the ability to obtain an abortion in Florida?

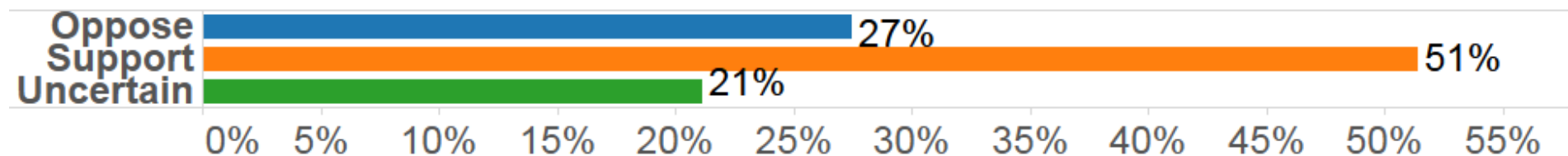

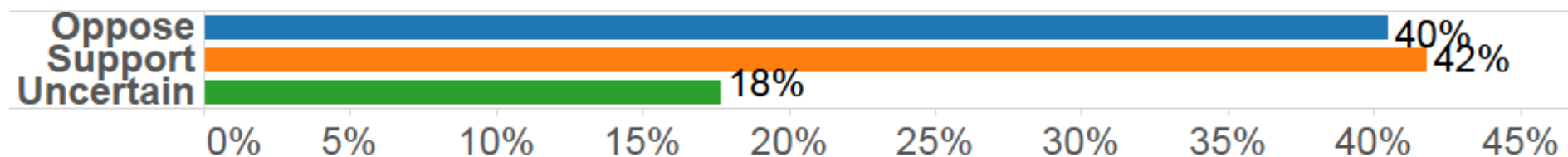

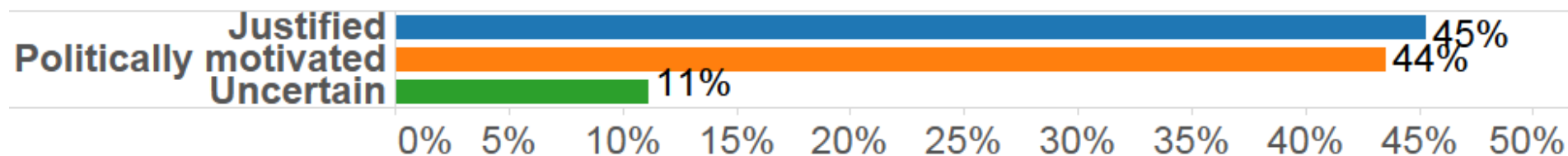
29) Do you support or oppose President Trump's actions regarding removing the United States from the Iranian Nuclear Agreement?

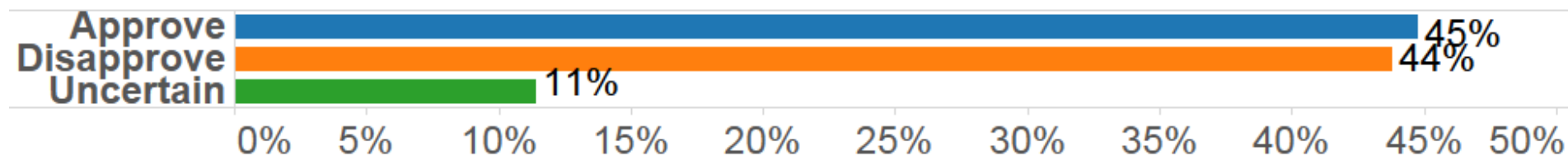

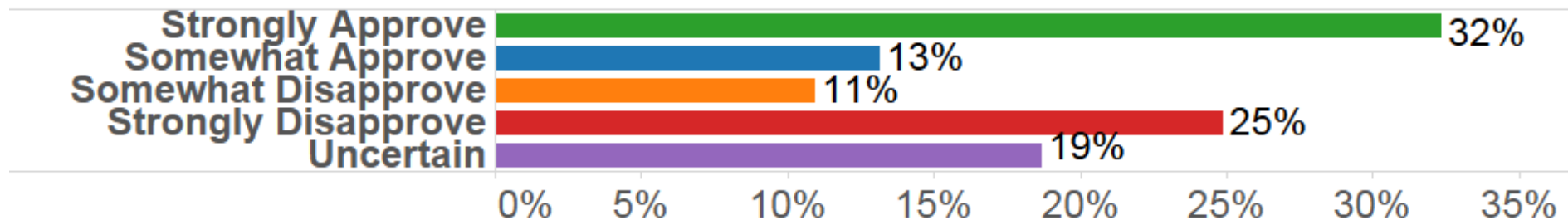
31) Would you approve or disapprove of a border wall built between the border of Mexico and the U.S.?

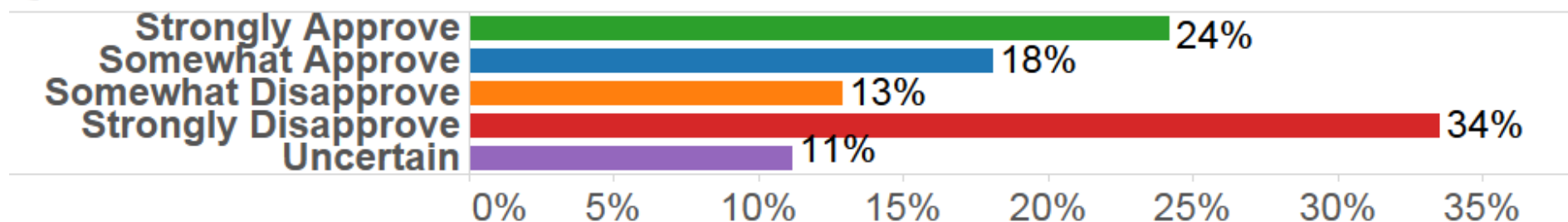

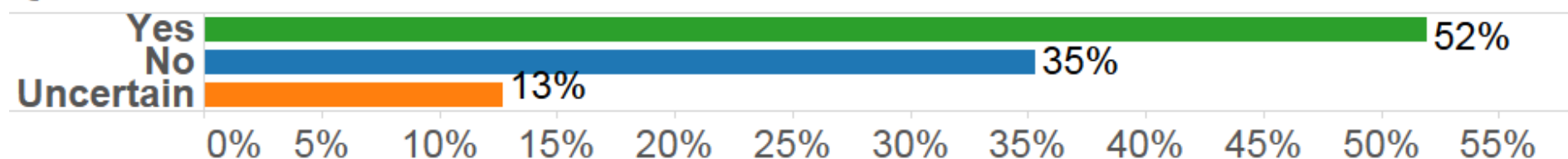

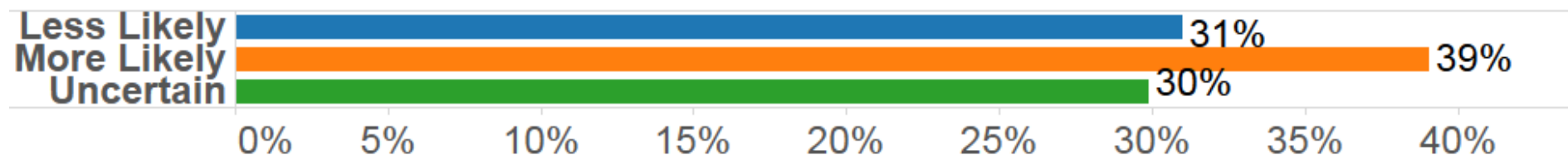

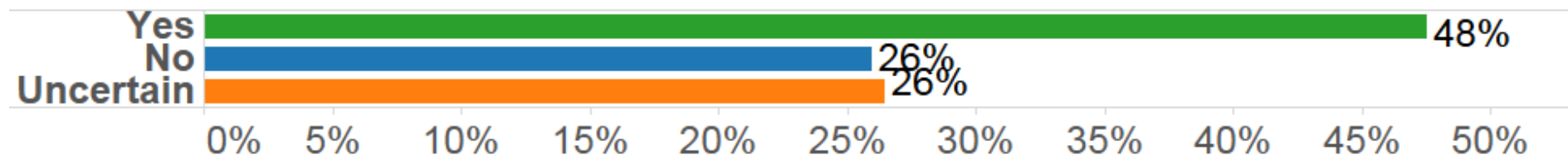

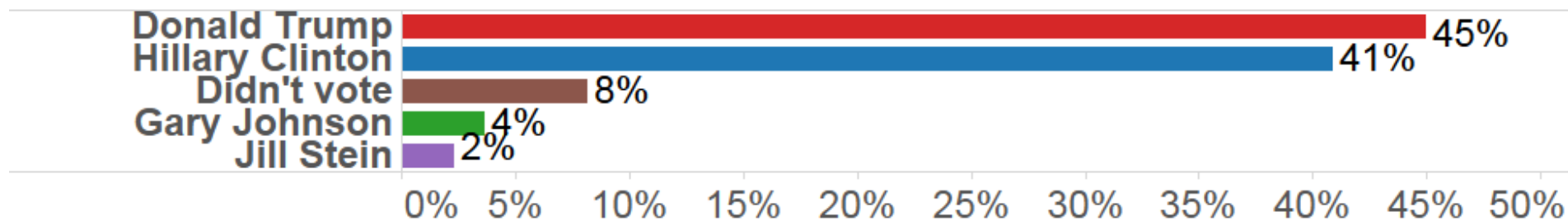

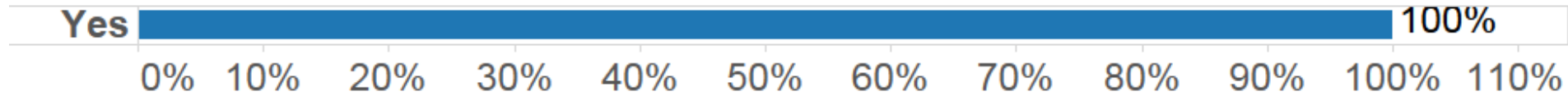

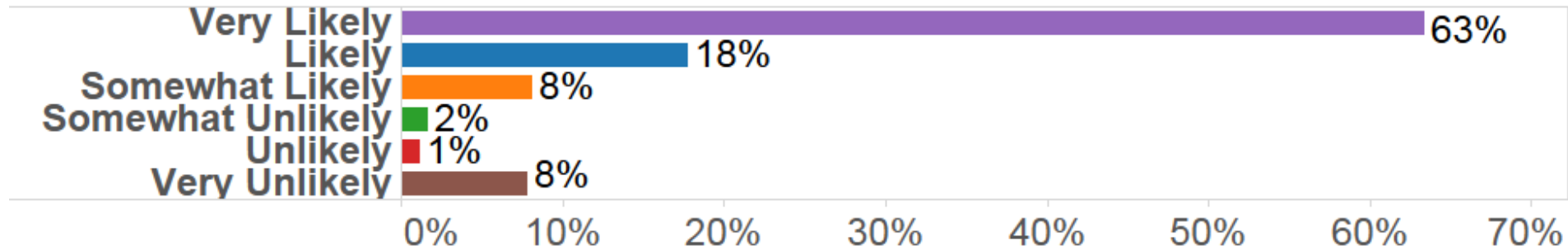

2) How likely are you to vote in the upcoming Florida Primary Elections?

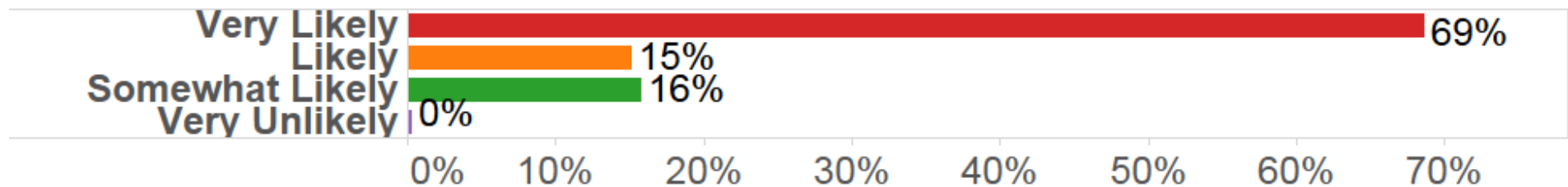
Q2: LIKELIHOOD PRIMARY

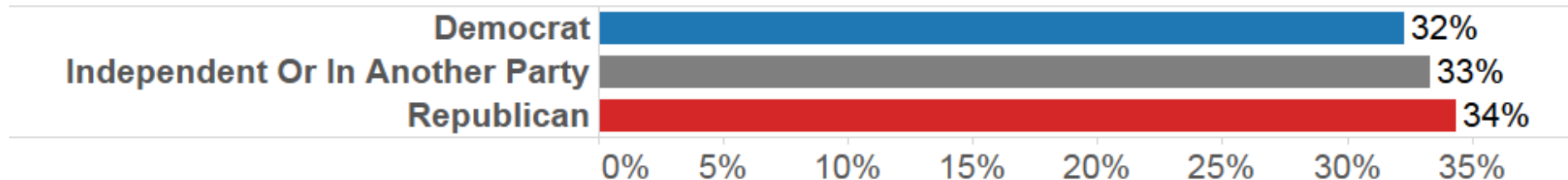

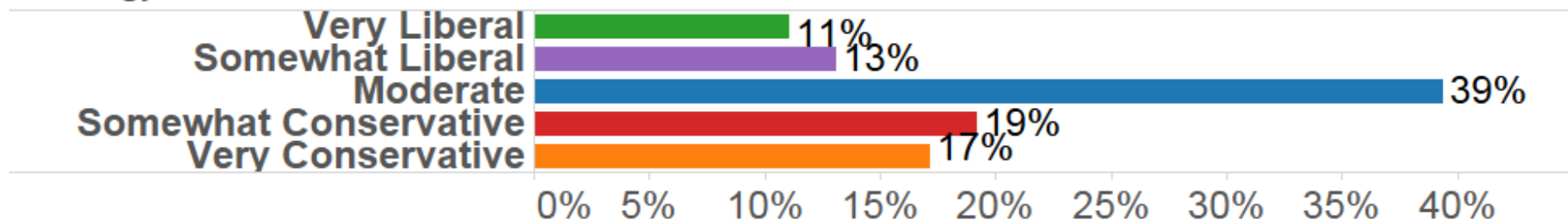

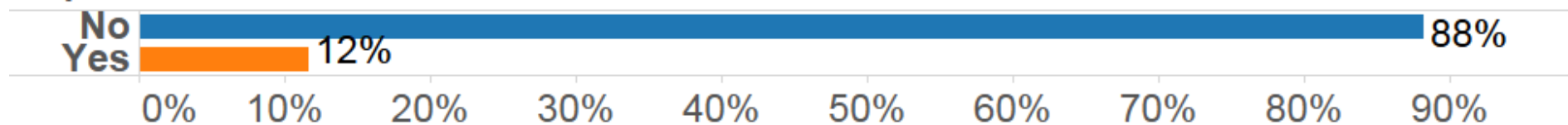
39) What is your political ideology?

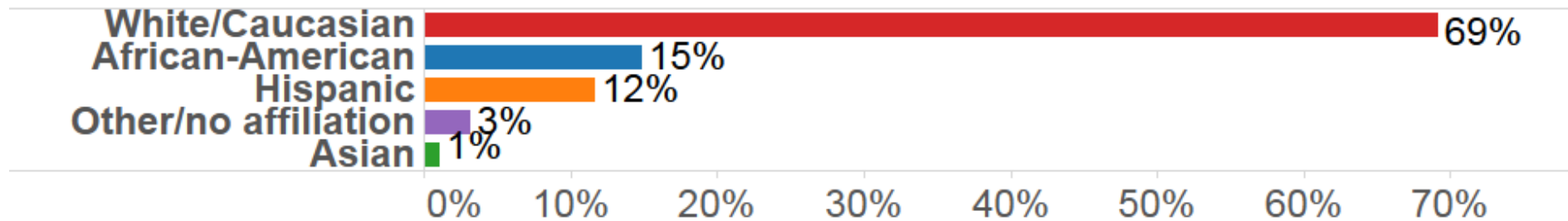
40) Are you or is a member of your immediate family from a Latino, Hispanic or Spanish speaking background?

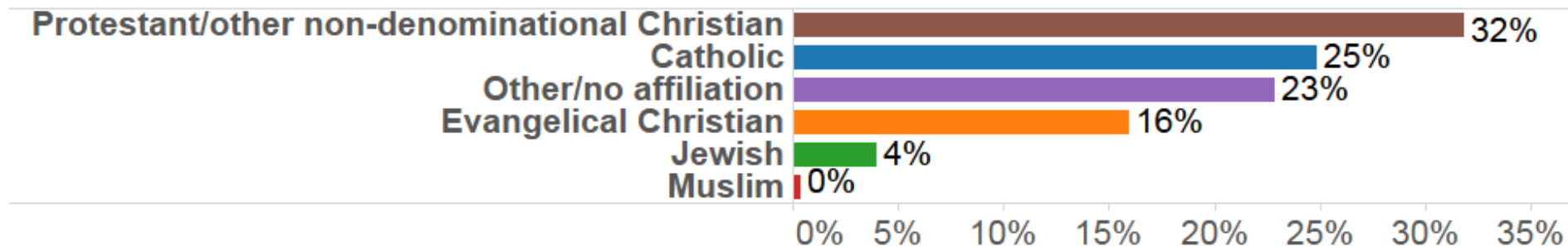

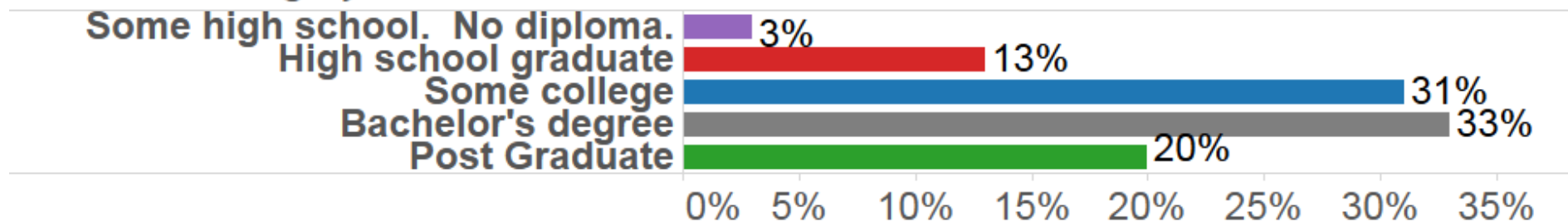
42) Which of the following best represents your religious affiliation?

Religious affiliation



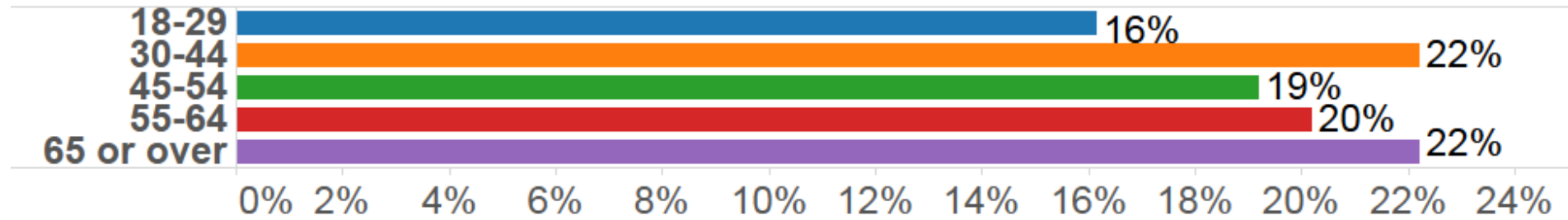
43) What is the highest level of education you have completed?
