

**INTERVIEWS: Doug Kaplan, 407-242-1870**

Gravis Marketing, a nonpartisan research firm, conducted a random survey of 628 likely voters across Alabama. The poll was conducted from November 14th through November 15th and has a margin of error of  $\pm 3.5\%$ . The totals may not round to 100% because of rounding. The survey was conducted using interactive voice responses and an online panel of cell phone users. The results are weighted by voting demographics.
