Survey conducted August 3 through August 5, 2018. 2,769 likely 2018 Republican Primary Election voters participated in the survey. Survey weighted to match expected turnout demographics for the 2018 Republican Primary Election. Margin of Error is +/-2% with a 95% level of confidence. Totals do not always equal 100% due to rounding.

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Q1: What is your opinion of Jeff Colyer?

Favorable: 43%
Unfavorable: 30%
No opinion: 27%

Favorable: 41%
Unfavorable: 46%
No opinion: 13%
