Survey conducted June 20 through June 21, 2018. 703 likely 2018 Republican Primary Election voters participated in the survey. Survey weighted to match expected turnout demographics for the 2018 Republican Primary Election. Margin of Error is +/-3.7% with a 95% level of confidence. Totals do not always equal 100% due to rounding.

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Q1: What is your opinion of Donald Trump?

Favorable: 83%
Unfavorable: 11%
No opinion: 6%

Q2: What is your opinion of Dan Donovan?

Favorable: 55%
Unfavorable: 26%
No opinion: 19%

Q3: What is your opinion of Michael Grimm?

Favorable: 45%
Unfavorable: 37%
No opinion: 18%
