### **2018 REPUBLICAN RUNOFF ELECTION**

Survey conducted August 1 through August 2, 2018. 1,757 likely 2018 Republican Runoff Election voters participated in the survey. Survey weighted to match expected turnout demographics for the 2018 Republican Runoff Election. Margin of Error is +/-2.3% with a 95% level of confidence. Totals do not always equal 100% due to rounding.
